### Notts & Derby District B.T.C. Open Show December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2011 Judge: Mr Mark Young

Notts & Derby Bull Terrier Club held an Open Show where the top honours were shared equally between the coloureds and whites. Each a credit to their owners and breeders, presented, as you would expect in first class condition.

However, just a small but important point, I noticed a fairly large proportion of both sexes exhibited needed their teeth cleaned. Surprisingly even in some of the younger animals they were in very poor condition. Not only does the Standard call for 'sound, clean teeth' but the health benefits are obvious. The temperament in all animals was excellent.

#### Puppy Dog (5 Entries)

1. Seward's **Padhen The Puzzler**. Smart, good sized 9 months br/w, powerful shapely head, keen expression, good earset, well made with good bone and substance throughout, really neat feet and strong quarters. A little unsettled at times but he moved well both ways, in good condition.

#### 2. Simpson's **Wengormick Wicked Streak**.

White with ear mark, decent headed puppy with good mouth. Could have had more fill and strength to his head. A compactly made young dog in good condition. Moved close behind and not the head of 1.

#### Novice Dog (5 Entries)

#### 1. Keeble's **Grazami Rambo's Son Of Honour**.

Substantial white dog, good head, just lacks enough fill between the eyes. Good mouth, good bone, made well with good front, body and hindquarters, moved reasonably well.

#### 2. Binks' **Jayston White Warrior**.

Compact white dog, shapely head although a little plain with a mouth fault, ears are a little loose. Decently made front, body and quarters with enough bone and substance, neat feet. Moved OK not quite the head of 1.

#### 3. Howe & Hutton's **Red Razzle Dazzle**.

#### Junior Dog (4 Entries)

#### 1. Blair's **Megaville Plenty More**.

Attractive quality white, shapely head without exaggeration, keen expression with good mouth. Straight front into strong body with the right amount of bone, nice tidy feet with strong quarters, moving well in front and slightly closer behind. At just over a year old a well balanced young dog who was presented and handled well.

#### 2. Atkins' **Hentarw Executive Decision**.

Handsome substantial tri, very good head. Carrying just the right amount of weight, good front, shapely body which could have been shorter, decent hindquarters, moved reasonably well. A

very smart dog, just preferred the overall balance of 1.

#### 3. Smith's **Romantic Mystic Ice**.

#### Post Graduate Dog (4 Entries)

#### 1. Kettleborough's **Bullysoul To Hard To Handle**.

Attractive br/w, good sized dog with beautiful head, good amount of bone for his size, good neck, front with feet and strong body with good topline. Would like to have seen more strength in his hindquarters to complete the picture. A smart brindle dog with good overall make and shape.

#### 2 Harper's **Olympusbulys Home Alone**.

White with red eye mark, compact body, reasonably good head, needs more turn and fill. Compact shapely body and well made hindquarters, moved OK both ways. Not quite the strength of head of 1.

#### 3. Littlefair's **Dikram Devils Deputy**.

#### Limit Dog (4 Entries)

#### 1. Griffiths' **Hentarw Welsh Warrior From Penpych**.

#### Best Dog & Best In Show

Very impressive well marked b/br with strong classical head, good neck, shoulders, forechest leading into short back with good topline and tailset, strong body is matched with muscular hindquarters, moved with real purpose. Very minor mouth fault which is easily carried by this quality dog. Every inch a male Bull Terrier, masculine, fit, full of character, in good condition and showed himself off to maximum benefit.

#### 2. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Berties Brother**.

B/br, powerful head which needs more fill and profile to complete the picture, ears are slightly wide apart and he has a mouth fault. Good straight front, strong shapely body and decent quarters. Not the head or presence of 1 but a well made dog you have to go over fully to appreciate.

#### 3. Hollindrake's **Activior Grand Finale For Bulian**.

#### Open Dog (7 Entries)

#### 1. Saunders' **Jayston Yasmino's Boy**. **Reserve Best Dog & Reserve Best In Show**

Very smart tri, full of type, good unexaggerated head with well placed ears. Super front, short compact body, standing foursquare, good quarters, moved well. Quality well marked coloured who was in gleaming condition. Just lost out in the challenge in overall maturity and not quite the exuberance as the eventual winner. Ideally I would like to have seen a few more pounds on him over the loin, otherwise a stylish dog and a lovely one to own.

#### 2. Morgans' **Marshelsea Trouble Coming At Romagna**.

Smart white dog with ear markings, long shapely head with good mouth. Straight front, good shoulders and overall body shape. A little too much rise over the loin, moved well both ways. A balanced dog, not as compact as 1 and different in type. Beautifully trained, handled and presented.

#### 3. Wannop & Crossan's **Son Of Legends**.

#### Veteran (4 Entries)

Lovely see these mature animals competing here, all were a credit to their owners, always a difficult class to judge.

#### 1. Haase's **Bavazuela Ingemar Joh**.

Good sized 7½ years white dog, pleasing head with mouth fault, nice neck and front, good length of body, well balanced, moved with purpose and still has a presence about him. Well balanced dog with good outline, in good condition.

#### 2. Quinn's **Duch Of Curdin**.

Attractive well marked br/w bitch, quality head with good profile, her eye is slightly kind. Good bone for her size with good front and length to back. Slightly straight in stifle and moved accordingly in the rear. At 8½ years she is still a pretty, feminine bitch. Showed and handled very well.

#### 3. Heath & Morris' **Bluepoint Stroller Pal**.

#### Brood Bitch (3 Entries)

All absent.

#### Puppy Bitch (8 Entries)

#### 1. Brown's **Tulsadoom Terry's All Gold**.

#### Best Puppy & Best Bitch

Real eye-catcher, beautiful substantial bitch with an ear and head mark, had the advantage of being slightly more mature than others in her class, extremely well finished for her age. Very good filled head and expression with one tight canine, arched neck into good straight front, well rounded body with decent length of back. Just the right amount of bone, her hindquarters are strong and she moved well for a puppy. Nice blend of power, substance and femininity, presented beautifully and handled considerably.

#### 2. Twyman & Gardner's **Zaracle Zofia For Larabelle**.

Different type of bitch to 1, white with eye mark, powerful well turned head, perfect mouth and well set ears, straight front, tidy feet, slightly upright in shoulder leading into a short back and high set tail. Good outline while standing and moved well, in good condition. Preferred the overall balance of 1.

#### 3. Szewczyk's **Quentinhill Black Swan**.

#### Novice Bitch (10 Entries)

#### 1. Kersey's **Emred Snowbird**.

White with eye patch, pretty feminine head, perhaps needs a touch more strength but still only a puppy. Just the right amount of bone for her size, good neck, front and lovely shapely body, good feet, well angulated hindquarters, moved well for a youngster. Nicely balanced bitch with good make and shape throughout, in good condition.

#### 2. Bowyer & Mountford's **Bluepoint Fathom**.

Big substantial upstanding br/w, well marked with powerful head and good mouth, smart bitch with plenty of substance, good front and shape to body although slightly long. Decent quarters, would just have liked more strength here and more drive on the move, as she was close behind. Not quite as compact as 1.

#### 3. L'Homme's **Goodbye To Helen Wheels**.

#### Junior Bitch (4 Entries)

#### 1. Hammill's **Tiapan's Starlight Express**.

Elegant white with ear marks, beautiful head, good mouth and expression, in very good condition, sound and well balanced, lovely neat feet, strong hindquarters, moved well.

#### 2. Littlefair's **Dikrams Black Magic**.

B/br, powerful headed bitch. Straight front, slightly upright in shoulder, good topline although slightly long in body and feet could be tighter. Not quite the shoulder and length of body of 1.

#### Post Graduate Bitch (7 Entries)

#### 1. Fitzherbert-Stewart's **Ounsdale Mighty Medusa**.

Beautifully well marked br/w, lovely head completely turned and filled, good mouth, well put together and soundly made with an excellent neck, front and shoulders, deep well rounded body and strong hindquarters, moved well, very nice bitch overall, in excellent condition.

#### 2. O'Connell's **Elvroc Who Dares Wins At Koellen**.

White with strong head but needs more strength to muzzle, generally well made with nice front, good bone and substance throughout, decent body, moved reasonably well. Her coat was a little out of condition, preferred the overall quality of 1.

#### 3. Galla's **Holyhead From Black And White Gypsies To Vetsbullies**.

#### Limit Bitch (7 Entries)

#### 1. Taylor's **Bullywood Avenging Star To Ragnarok**.

#### Reserve Best Bitch

Very smart all white, long filled elegant head, dark small eye with piercing expression, perfect mouth. Not a big bitch but full of quality, type and nicely balanced, lovely front with flowing body lines, tidy feet, good topline and tailset, moved well both ways, beautifully presented feminine terrier type bitch, in lovely condition and was carefully considered in the final line-up.

#### 2. Szewczyk's **Carramba Quentin Hill**.

Substantial white with red ear marks, completely different in type to 1. Power packed head with good mouth, good neck, shoulders, deep ribcage and good hindquarters, topped off with bone to match.

#### 3. Pilkington's **Javarke Javita**.

#### Open Bitch (10 Entries)

#### 1. Sheppard, Howes & Taylor's **Ragnarok Daralis At Polanca**.

Br/w, super strong head, pronounced profile and good mouth, nice front, neat compact feet, feminine shapely body with decent hindquarters. Could be a little shorter in back. She moves with real drive never taking her eyes of her handler. A bitch full of spirit and energy, in gleaming condition, excellently handled and presented.

#### 2. Szewczyk's **Quentinhill Say You Love Me**.

Br/w, feminine head, good length of neck, front, body to match and good hindquarters. Moved OK in front and close behind. Another nice bitch, not quite the movement and condition of 1.
