Puppy Dog (3 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Blair's **Megaville Plenty More.**

Best Puppy & Reserve Best Male

One year old pure white male, nice head with fill down to the end, finished with a perfect bite, used ears well with well placed eyes, he is nicely built with good lines, strong bone, short in back with a correct tail set. Good angulation front and rear complimented his movement coming and going.

2. Twyman & Gardner's **Laronbelle's Magic Vision.**

Another 1 year old white carrying brindle, nice head, would prefer more fill under the eyes, strong bone, compact, excellent mover, could benefit by a little more ring training. Should do well in the future.

3. Biggins' **Wengormick Wise Venture.**

Junior Dog (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Robert's **Teirwgwyn Head Banger.**

1½ year old white male with a very nice head, needing a tip more fill and more nose pigment, short in back, nice strong bone, good forechest, good feet and moves well with reach and drive.

Novice Dog (4 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Robert's **Teirwgwyn Billy Boy.**

Best Male, Best of Opposite Sex, Reserve Best in Show

A little over 1 year of age, outstanding tri-colour with a beautiful head that is strong and packed down to the nose, mouth OK with two incisors off, short in back, very nice bone, good angulation and tail set, excellent mover. A real eye-catcher!

2. Keeble's **Grazami Rambo's Son of Honour.**

1½ year old white male with a nice profile good ear set and expression but would prefer a bit more fill under the eyes, short in back, good substance, good sized bone, correct tail set, moves with reach and drive coming and going.

Post Graduate Dog (5 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Littlefair's **Dikram Devils Deputy.**

A little over 2½ year old white male, correct mouth and decent head, good ear set, a tip upright in shoulder but good spring of ribs and excellent bone, moved well in front and though well-angulated in the rear, moved a little close behind.

2. Rowland's **Meiow Maximus.**

2½ year old tri-colour male that fills the eye, exuding type, bone and substance, with an outstanding head, filled and packed topped off with a great expression, very nice movement though could use a tad more rear angulation. Though his canines are correct, it was unfortunate that his mouth is sadly overshot.

Limit Dog (6 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Marples' **Taylajay Look No Further.**

Slightly over 1 year old very nice brindle and white, head filled right up with correct ear set and a good expression, excellent bone and substance for his size, would prefer better shoulder angulation and tighter elbows, but still moved well.

2. Thomson's **Nethanbull's Poetic Bragg.**

3 year old black brindle male with a very nice head and correct bite, though I would have preferred slightly more turn, a nice middle of the road type with good bone and substance, just a tip long in back. Very nice angulation behind and a nice mover.

3. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Bertie's Brother.**

Open Dog (4 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Wannop & Crossan's **Son of Legends.**

21 month old white male, good head with length, well placed ears and a wicked expression though I would have preferred a bit more fill, strong shapely body, short back and nice bone. Overall a nice boy.

2. Toner's **Angus.**

3 year old white male carrying brindle with an excellent head, correct bite and lovely eye, deep brisket and well sprung ribs with nice bone and feet, moves very well, unfortunately his topline did not hold on the move.

Puppy Bitch (6 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Twyman & Gardiner's **Zaracle Zofia for Laronbelle.**

Best Puppy Bitch

10 month old white bitch carrying brindle, very nice head but I would prefer a tip more turn, good bone, nice forechest for her age, good topline and a very good mover.

2. Wright's **Megaville's After Tonight at Rightstuff.**

1 year old white bitch who would benefit with more ring training, excellent head though needs a tip more turn, nice expression, good ear placement, nice bone and topline, proper tail set, rear angulations OK, moved well both ways, she just needs to tighten up but that will come with maturity.

3. Mawson's **Lady the Second.**

Junior Bitch (9 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Fitzherbert-Stewart's **Ounsdale Mighty Medusa at Locoville.**

Reserve Best Bitch

1½ year old brindle bitch. Lovely head, excellent body outline with good bone, ear and eye placement, nice angulation all around seen in her nice movement, she excels in all areas.

2. Baines' **Street Dancer.**

1½ year old white carrying brindle bitch with nice body lines, lovely head with a very good profile that just needs more

width, correct bite, nice rear angulation with good rear movement, would like to see a cleaner front.

3. Baines' **Persian Warrior.**

Maiden Bitch (4 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Lever's **Meiow Bramble Rose by Borsalino.**

1½ year old brindle bitch, very nice head, needs a tip more turn but filled to the end, would prefer deeper under-jaw but she has a correct bite, enough bone and substance, lovely cat feet, overall excellent body lines, but she lost topline on the move.

Novice Bitch (7 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Bowyer & Mountford's **Bluepoint Fathom.**

8 month old brindle, very attractive bitch with a beautiful head, lovely expression and ear set, nice layback of shoulder, good topline though a tip long in back, with good rear angulation and a good front, would benefit losing 1 or 2 pounds. Moved freely both ways.

2. Wright's **Rightstuff Re Spek Ta Bull.**

A little over 1 year old bitch with a lovely mahogany brindle colour that is sadly lacking in the breed, very nice head with a strong under-jaw and correct bite, but would prefer a tip more fill, built very nicely with good bone, moves well both ways.

3. Hick's **Khlolander Chic Shanique at Crisalia.**

Post Graduate Bitch (4 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Heath's **Bluepoint Fire Bird.**

8 month old heavyweight red smut, beautiful head from ears to nose, lovely body with ample substance, though could be shorter coupled, and for her size, would benefit from a tip more bone, lovely forechest and nice angulation, very good movement both ways.

Limit Bitch (3 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Hearne & Singleton's **Warbonnet Illusion.**

Best Bitch and Best in Show

A little over 3 year old nicely built white bitch with an excellent head, smooth, turned and finished profile with fill along with depth and width to complete the picture, level bite, good topline and underline, short in back, shapely body with ample bone and substance, nice feet, if I were to be picky I would prefer a better tail placement. Excellent angulation front and back, moves well both ways.

2. Roberts' **Teirwgwyn Treacle Tart.**

Nearly 5 year old tri-colour, powerful bitch, beautiful head lacking nothing, lovely expression, good ear and eye set, very well balanced throughout, very good rear movement, her front could be cleaner and her mouth is undershot. She was handled to perfection.

Open Bitch (7 Entries, 6 Absent)

1. Heath's **Bluepoint Pretty Special.**

5½ year old very nice brindle bitch, excellent head packed and filled, would like a tinier eye, nice under-jaw and good earset, good bone, moves freely, would benefit by losing 1-2 pounds and is a tad soft in the topline.
