Thank you for the invitation to judge at South Eastern Counties Bull Terrier Club. My stewards were very helpful and knowledgeable and I would like to extend my appreciation to them. Overall, there was a high standard of animals present. I very much enjoyed the day.

Special Beginners Dog

1. Bullyview Take A Bow.

Heavyweight black brindle dog with strong profile and packed head, bite undershot and a soft ear. Short backed, well coupled dog but a little stuffy in neck, moved well both ways.

Puppy Dog

1. Laronbelle's Magic Visions.

Nice upstanding white dog with brindle eye patch. Good all round dog with a perfect bite. Could use a little stronger head and underjaw. Short backed with good round bone. Would like a better shoulder angulation but a nice back end, moved true coming and going.

2. Ducassos Dominator.

Nice short backed white dog with slight mismatch. Quality head with well-placed incisors, one tight canine. Touch loose on the elbows but didn't show his best today.

3. Emmanaitch The Pirate.

Junior Dog

1. Bilboen Velocity.

Very promising young dog with a show stopping profile, wicked eyes, straight front, good forechest and level topline. Would like a touch more stifle angulation, but due to his over exuberance very difficult to assess on the day.

2. Bobuddy Fuegos Fusilier.

Brindle dog with a nice profile, short back and good bite. Movement a little loose, needs more time to body up and mature.

3. Stockleyview Born To Be King.

Novice Dog

1. Ragnarok Helmdallr.

A big white powerhouse of a dog, beautiful round bone, tight feet, gun barrel front, short compact with a perfect bite. Only let down by his lack of profile. His movement is parallel and true with drive, by far the best mover on the day.

2. Romagna Mystic Ice.

Quality white dog, straight front, short back, good lay of shoulder, could use a touch more profile and fill, moved well coming and going.

Post Graduate Dog

1. Barking At The Moon With Bilboen.

Reserve Best Dog

Upstanding white dog with cracking

profile and wicked expression.

Good bite, lay of shoulder and rear angulation, level topline. Lacking weight and a little out of condition today.

2. Kerbulls Rising Son.

Lovely strong coloured tri dog. Cracking head, good ear placement, short backed cobby boy with a level bite. Short in upper arm and shoulder placement affects his front movement.

3. Olympusbulys Home Alone.

Limit Dog

1. Badlesmere Bertie's Brother.

Very Showy black brindle dog, adequate fill to his head, good front and short back. Touch upright in shoulder and would like a little more profile. Moved better in front, close behind. Very well handled.

2. Bilboen Love n' Kisses.

Quality red and white dog with good profile and fill, nice round bone, good front, feet, fore chest, rear assembly and short back. An instanding canine, shortness in neck and his reluctance to show today kept him from the 1st place.

Open Dog

1. Marshelsea Trouble Coming At Romagna.

Best Dog, Best Opposite Sex & Reserve Best In Show

Top quality powerful white dog. Stands four-square, short backed with a wicked expression. Nice profile, deep strong packed head with a good bite. Nice lay of shoulder, good forechest and correct bend of stifle. Just lost topline a touch on the move, but moved true coming and going.

2. Ragnarok Gungnir.

Powerful white dog with a lovely packed up head, good profile, good bone and substance, nicely balanced dog. Touch short in upper arm. Presented and handled very well.

3. Kersharella Thundercloud At Odyom.

Special Beginners Bitch

1. Shanthana Thai Black Orchid.

Cobby tri-colour bitch, good rear end, well angled stifles, slightly upright in shoulder, instanding canine, lacking in profile. Moved well coming and going.

2. Simbartahill Tell Tail Lass.

Very up on leg brindle and white bitch, sweeping profile, bite incorrect, needs a little more bone and substance.

3. Badlesmere Bring Me Luck.

Puppy Bitch

1. Zaracle Zofia For Laronbelle.

Best Puppy

Compact square white girl with perfect dentition, very strong profile, good expression and ear placement, lovely rear end. Short in upper arm. Showed like a bomb for her owner, a real picture.

2. Emred Snowbird.

Quality well made bitch, short, square, level topline, good front and rear with a perfect bite. Moved true in front, a little close behind. Would like a touch more profile. Excellently handled and presented.

3. Ducassos Proud Mary.

Junior Bitch

1. Dark Velvet Dark.

Ultra feminine brindle and white bitch. Smooth well arced profile, good bite and feet, well angled stifles. Slightly upright in shoulder and a touch light in bone. Showed and presented well.

2. Blueskybully Lightnin' Bolt.

Black, brindle and white bitch with good dentition, well made, good topline. Head lacks in profile and fill, moved wide coming and close going.

3. Blink Of An Eye.

Novice Bitch

1. Ragnarok Idunna.

Reserve Best Bitch

Short backed elegant white bitch, nice profile with good fill, carries ears a touch wide. Good front leading into tight cat-like feet.

Square girl with good topline, a touch straight in stifle. Moved well in front, close behind. Very well handled and presented.

2. Bullbrazen Black Rose.

Lovely headed brindle and white bitch, sweeping profile, good reach of neck, good topline, front and rear end. Incisors just off, moved true in front, close behind.

Post Graduate Bitch

1. Kholander Chic Shanique At Crisalia.

Stunning white bitch with a sweeping profile, completely packed and filled head, elegant reach of neck, a square picture from the side with a level topline, well muscled second thigh and excellent bend of stifle. A touch upright in shoulder, but it is only this girl's under bite stopping her from taking top honours.

2. Elvroc Who Dares Wins at Koellen.

Limit Bitch

1. Bullywood Avenging Star To Ragnarok.

Best Bitch & Best In Show

Gorgeous, feminine white girl. Lovely clean profile and fill with perfect bite, long sweeping neck, straight front, good feet, level topline, nice bend of stifle and second thigh. To be ultra critical, would like a little more forechest, but moved true coming and going. A girl destined for top honours.
