I was very pleased with the large number of entries, and the very few absences. The quality was excellent and there were many tough decisions to make throughout the day.

Beginners Dog (1 Entry)

1. Twyman & Gardner's **Laronbelle's Magic Vision**.

1 year white with brindle eye patch, heavyweight, white bull type dog, strong well filled head with good depth and width, perfect mouth, powerful neck into good shoulders and a straight front, heavy round bone, deep brisket, moved well both ways.

Puppy Dog (3 Entries)

1. Foster's **Bilboen Velocity**.

Reserve Best Dog
8 months white with brindle ears, good strong head and profile without being overdone, correct mouth, small dark eye and correct earset, correct bone for type, shapely bodylines, straight front with tight feet, very excited to be here and gave his handler some fun!

2. Cserfalvi-Young's **Ducassos Dominator**.

10 months white, nice puppy with much to appreciate, nice wide head with fill and depth, a tad less brow would complete it, good expression, nice bone, good front and shoulder.

Junior Dog (3 Entries)

1. Pullin's **Louka Gone Racin'**.

15 months b/br, medium sized with a nice wide packed and filled head with lovely turn, good expression, perfect bite, moves true both in front and rear, time and maturity is on his side.

2. Atkins' **Hentarw Executive Decision**.
14 months tri, very sound with everything in the right place, pleasing head with good turn and fill, nice expression and a good bite, good movement.

3. Keenor's **Bobuddy Fuego's Fusilier**.

Novice Dog (2 Entries)

1. Cserfalvi-Young's **Ducassos Detonator**.

10 months white, attractive head, scissors bite, decent bone, nice make and shape, nice neck into topline, at first was too excited and so front movement was not good with too much action and lack of coordination, once settled he moved very well, nice short back.

2. Latham's **Kellouacy One Of Many**.

Tri, strong, nicely turned head, bite fractionally off, straight front plus good feet, good movement in front, close in rear, well presented.

Limit Dog (4 Entries)

1. Harper's **Olympusbuly's Home Alone**.

White with red eye marking, nice dog, very good bone, long strong head, nice down-face, perfect bite, good reach of neck, nice lay of shoulder and straight front. A tad long in back. Moved well.

2. Rosser's **King Arthur The Legend**.

Striking r/w with super virtues of

substance, power and quality, head is wide and beautifully filled, very acceptable profile, nice neck, front is good although was a bit elbowy, moved nicely.

3. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Berties Brother**.

Open Dog (3 Entries)

A tough class to judge as on another day any one of these three could win the class.

1. Morgans' **Marshelsea Trouble Coming At Romagna**.

Best Dog & Best In Show

Handsome white with black brindle ears, a real powerhouse, stood foursquare with a very short loin, head is wide and deep with a very good smooth profile, excellent expression, correct bite, good straight front legs are tucked right under his chest, lots of rib spring and depth, correct topline, well bent stifles and short well let down hocks, moved freely and handled very well.

2. Sheehy's **Fortifer Firefoot For Afanbull**.

Very nice solid r/smut, good profile, correct bite, wide strong well filled up head, cobby body with lots of substance, showed and moved well in both directions.

3. White's **Stockleyview Fantastica**.

Veteran (2 Entries)

1. Malden's **Louka What Popped Out The Hat**.

7 years white with b/br ears, very good profile with a long head, correct bite, excellent bone and substance, moved well, was nice to later judge her daughter and granddaughter in subsequent classes.

2. Nelson's **Angel River**.

7 years white with b/br ears, pleasing head with good turn and fill, nice expression and good bite, moved true both in front and rear.

Beginners Bitch (5 Entries)

1. L'Homme's **Goodbye To Helen Wheels**.

Reserve Best Bitch

Very pretty all white, nice long head with good foreface and nice finish, ears right bang on top of head, correct bite, beautiful gun-barrel front, nice tight feet, nice make and shape, moved freely both ways.

2. Reed's **Blueskybully Lightning Bolt**.

Except in colour very similar to 1, smooth gentle profile, powerful fill and depth to head, correct bite, shapely well made behind the collar with a square outline, beautiful long neck, moved nicely.

3. Malden's **Louka Lady Luck**.

Puppy Bitch (4 Entries)

1. Kersey's **Emred Snowbird**.

Best Puppy

Elegant white puppy with brindle eye marking, lovely smooth profile, good fill, nice expression, correct bite, good length of neck, short backed, picturesque in silhouette, moved cleanly both ways, a lovely puppy!

2. Godsall's **Albaeda Singing The Blues For Neverland**.

Pretty white with eye and ear marking, a very pretty package, head has a nice profile, good eye and bite, an impressive degree of fill, good shoulder and rear angles, lovely neck, short back, beautiful front, moved well.

3. Cserfalvi-Young's **Ducassos Proud Mary**.

Junior Bitch (4 Entries)

1. Bloom & O'Neill's **Kholander Tropicana At Abenaki**.

Super headed r/w, head beautifully turned and filled with a strong muzzle, long neck, nice expression, good bone and feet, very good depth of chest and spring of rib, moved well both ways.

2. Malden's **Louka Madam Mischief**.

Attractive white with b/br ear, very nice all around, gently turned feminine head with roman finish, correct bite, nice make and shape, moved and showed well, having also judged her mother and grandmother, she was my favourite of the three, a credit to her breeder who is improving with each generation.

3. Waycott's **Fortifer Freijas Formula At Waybully**.

Novice Bitch (7 Entries)

1. Sheehy's **Wellinghall Taylor Maid For Afanbull**.

White with brindle ear, gentle smooth profile, good fill and power, correct bite, well constructed at both ends, moved well all ways.

2. Mainwaring's **Afanbull Too Much Too Young**.

White bitch with b/br ear, nice profile and fill, head long and full, correct bite, short coupled body, moved well.

3. Goldsmith's **Kendici Bell Of The Ball**.

Limit Bitch (3 Entries)

1. Moody's **Kirkville Golden Eye At Odyom**.

Brindle, head has good fill and a gently curved profile, good bite and earset, straight front and good bone for size, nice forechest, good reach of neck that flows into a level topline and good tailset, good rear angulation, in good condition.

2. Malden's **Louka Lady Luck**.

Upstanding white with a smooth gentle profile, good length to head, correct bite, good length of neck and front, adequate bone for size, moved well.

3. Waycott's **Fortifer Freijas Formula At Waybully**.

Open Bitch (6 Entries)

1. Howes, Sheppard & Taylor's **Ragnarok Daralis With Polanca**.

Best Bitch & Reserve Best In Show

Elegant and feminine with nice fill and dramatic downface, good eye, expression and tidy ears, deep underjaw, mouth correct, nicely made shoulders, back firm but could be a tad shorter. Plenty of bone and power for her moderate size, good angulation, covered ground nicely both ways and very well handled.

2. Richardson's **Dajan Gold Medal For Quayardson**.

Such a tough class, lovely white with two black eye and ear markings, smooth, long head filled right up, ears perfectly placed on the top of her head, correct bite, good level topline and clean undercarriage, nice rear angulation, moved beautifully.

3. Sheehy's **Wellinghall Ebony Nugget For Afanbull**.

Brood Bitch (3 Entries)

1. Malden's **Louka Lady Luck**.

2. Bunce's **Bilboen Shooting Star At Rubbish**.

White, short packed up head with small upright ears, great expression with tiny eyes, good topline and front, good hindquarters. Didn't want to settle today for handler and so didn't show her virtues to advantage.
