I was judging my first set of CC's at their most prestigious event. I was delighted at the overall quality of both the dogs and bitches, especially in construction and conformation and well placed shoulders.

**Veteran Dog** (1 Entry, 1 Absent)

**Puppy Dog** (1 Entry)  
1. Young's **Bullyview Mobsta**.  
**Best Puppy, Dog CC & Best Of Breed**  
White with head mark, what can I say about this stunning young dog, he exudes quality and screams look at me, his head is a beautiful egg shape with no indentations with a good profile, ears bang on top and wicked eye, long neck into well placed shoulder and level topline which he held well on the move, straight front with tidy feet and lots of forechest and spring of rib for one so young, and moved well both ways. Well handled and presented in beautiful condition, I was delighted to award him his third CC and although he is still a Puppy I'm certain this young boy has great future in front of him and I believe he can be a great asset to the breed. This young dog is without doubt one I would have loved to have taken home on the day.

**Junior Dog** (3 Entries)  
1. McDermid's **Padhen Hitman**.  
Large upstanding b/br/w, good profile with lots of fill, ears well set, nice eye, big boy with long neck and good front and forechest, nice spring of rib and depth of brisket, strong quarters, moved well both ways, still a young dog who I'm sure will improve as he matures.  
2. Jerome & Cambridge's **Ounsdale Return Of The Mac at Elysianplain**.  
B/br/w, sweeping profile with fill, wicked eye, used his ears all the time, cobby type, good straight front, short coupled with good rear end and moved well in front but a shade close behind.

**Novice Dog** (3 Entries)  
1. Carrick's **Bullbrand Solonius**.  
Very well made white, strong head filled up and good finish and pigmentation. I'd like his ears to be perhaps better placed. Lots of bone with straight front, well sprung rib, good rear quarters and moved well both ways, still quite a young dog who I can only think will improve with age.

2. Burton's **Rhino's Thunder**.  
B/br/w, very cobby type, gentle profile. I would like maybe a little more width in muzzle, he used his ears all time, good reach of neck and forechest and spring of rib, good rear quarter and moved close both ways.

**Post Graduate Dog** (4 Entries)  
1. Gardner & Twyman's **Laronbelle's Magic Vision**.  
Large upstanding white with head mark, strong head with lots of fill under his eye, good profile, nice roman finish, good pigmentation, powerful shoulder and level topline, good front, tidy feet, strong rear end and moved well both ways with drive.  
2. Marples' **Taylajay Look No Further**.  
Very well made br/w, he is a compact dog, great profile, his head is filled right up, very strong with nice roman finish, neck is broad with lots of strength in his shoulders, back is short coupled and his rear quarters are very powerful when he moved albeit a little close from behind, lovely dog but his cross is his front which could be a little better, handled and presented well.  
3. Pullen's **Louka Gone Racin**.

**Limit Dog** (4 Entries)  
1. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Bertie's Brother**.  
B/br/w, nice head, I'd prefer a little more fill. Ears well set, small eye and nicely placed shoulders, level topline, straight front, good forechest with depth of brisket and good rear quarters, moved close both ways.  
2. Taylor's **Ragnarok Radolf**.  
Re-import, well marked r/w, big boy with good bone and substance, sweeping profile, ears correct, lots of fill, long reaching neck, good shoulders and topline, straight front, he played himself in the ring.  
3. Demartis' **Ade**.

**Open Dog** (4 Entries)  
1. Griffiths' **Hentarw Welsh Warrior From Penpych**.  
**Dog Reserve CC**  
B/br/w, nice well balanced cobby type, nice box shape, good head and profile, used his ears all the time, good shoulder and topline, straight front, nice short back, good spring of rib and well muscled rear quarters, moved well both ways with purpose and drive.  
2. Morgans' **Marshelsea Trouble Coming At Romagna**.  
Large upstanding white bull type, strong head, good fill, very powerful, he could do perhaps with more profile. Good width and depth of muzzle, wicked eye and ears well on top, big strong boy with lots of bone and substance. Tends to lose his topline when moving but moved wide both ways and with drive. Presented in beautiful condition, a credit to his owners.

**Puppy Bitch** (3 Entries)  
1. Foster's **Bilboen X-Rated**.  
What a smashing young girl, r/w well marked, only 9 months but showed well for her handler, nice feminine head, gentle profile, nice earset, good fill, good shoulder and level topline, good front, spring of rib and rear quarter, moved well in front but close behind.  
2. Waycott's **Ukusa Rhapsody For Waybully**.  
White with red head mark, very similar in type to class winner, good profile, used her ears all the time, nice fill with feminine expression, long neck into well placed shoulders, straight front, tidy feet, enjoyed herself in the ring and showed well for her owner.  
3. Jerome's **Elysianplain Miss Medusa**.

**Junior Bitch** (4 Entries)  
1. Ley & Broomfield's **Fortifer's Flametta**.  
R/w, very well packed girl, good bone and substance, strong head all filled up, nice eye and roman finish, strong neck, lots of spring of rib, level topline which she held well on the move, strong rear quarters and well developed second thigh, moved well both ways, well handled and presented.  
2. Waycott's **Ukusa Rhapsody For Waybully**.  
3. Brown's **Louka Pretty Lady**.

**Novice Bitch** (1 Entry)  
1. White's **Shanthana Thai Black Orchid**.  
Very well marked tri girl with lots of bone and substance, strong head yet still keeps her feminine expression, ears well set, good profile and fill, strong neck, gun barrel chest, also good round bone, shade long in back but as a bitch I'm happy with that, powerful rear quarters and bend of stifle, moved well both ways.

**Post Graduate Bitch** (3 Entries)  
1. Brown's **Tulsadoom Terry's All Gold**.  
**Bitch Reserve CC**  
White with brindle head mark, very beautiful girl, well balanced, her head is feminine yet strong and completely filled with a sweeping profile, wicked eye and used her ears all the time, good roman finish, lots of forechest and spring of rib, nice front, well placed shoulder and level topline with good rear angulation, moved well both ways, similar type to my CC winner.  
2. L'homme's **Goodbye To Helen Wheels**.  
Nice terrier type bitch, nice head, gentle profile, would like maybe a little more power under the eye. Nice roman finish and good pigmentation, straight front, tidy feet, good topline and good bend of stifle and rear angulation, moved OK in front and from behind.  
3. Davis' **Louka Summer Breeze**.

**Limit Bitch** (6 Entries)  
1. Fletcher's **Napier Mary Jane**.  
**Bitch CC**  
I liked with head mark, how do I start, I liked this bitch when she walked into the ring, big strong girl with a very strong head, all filled and power packed, good profile, nice roman finish, lots of bone and substance, good front, plenty of forechest with spring of rib, well placed shoulders and held her topline on the move, very strong quarters but moved wide in front and shade close behind, like the DCC, well handled and presented in nice clean condition.  
2. Konings & Berez's **Action Hot And Classy**.  
All white a very elegant bitch, beautiful feminine head, nice profile, wicked eye, good fill and roman finish, nice reach of neck, I liked her shoulder placement and her topline, she tends to turn her right foot out which spoils her look a little, lots of forechest and depth of brisket and good bend of stifle, moved well both ways, different type of bitch to class winner but nevertheless as her name suggest she is a very classy girl indeed, my thanks to her owners for bringing all the way from Holland and giving me the chance to see her.  
3. Howes, Sheppard & Taylor's **Ragnarok Daralis With Polanca**.

**Open Bitch** (3 Entries)  
1. Young's **Sp/UK Ch. Polaris Bull De Cabanas At Bullyview**.  
What a stunning bitch, catches your eye right away, she has great ring presence and is a well constructed, white with head marking, sweeping profile, well filled head with roman finish, good ear carriage, lovely eye, straight front, clean feet, good depth and well sprung rib, good shoulder and level topline, good bend of stifle and moved well from behind but a little close in front. Her coat was not all it could have been but I did look at her long and hard in the challenge.  
2. Hall's **Cwmdulais Ael Y Bryn**.  
Tri, well balanced bitch. I would like a little more strength in head but she has a nice profile, well placed ears and good roman finish, good pigmentation, straight front and spring of rib, level topline and moved well both ways.  
3. Taylor & Sheppard's **Bullywood Avenging Star To Ragnarok**.
