I have felt for a while now bitches have been better than the males but here I was also pleasantly surprised with the dogs, especially with my final line-up, and I wished I'd had more than one CC to hand out as a couple more well deserved a CC.

Puppy Dog (3 Entries, 1 Absent) 1. Young's **Bullyview Mobsta.** Best Puppy, Dog CC & Best Of Breed

What a stunning dog and still a puppy as was evident in the way he gave his owner a hard time, but when he needed to show himself off he did and I saw him. Strong head and super expression, excellent earset, deep chest, good topline, powerful quarters which he used, in top of all that a perfect mouth.
2. Green's **Bullybeaujay Red Admiral.**
Very immature r/w puppy, in gleaming condition, lovely temperament. Hope his owner continues as he showed him well.

Junior Dog (4 Entries, 1 Absent) 1. Lamonby's **Emred Devils Spy.** Dog Reserve CC

Young dog of quality and has matured nicely, strong head, keen expression, powerful neck into short back, good bone and powerful quarters that showed when he moved, handled and put down beautifully.
2. McDermid's **Padhen Hitman.**
Smart b/br, nice head, erect ears which he used well, perfect mouth, strong quarters, should mature into a very promising dog, not quite as finished as 1.

Novice Dog (5 Entries, 0 Absent) 1. Carrick's **Bullbrand Solonius.** Good dog and true to type, powerful head filled and turned, straight front, deep chest, certainly one to watch for the future. 2. Hall's **Magical Last Breath Of Cwmdulais.**

Nicely made young dog, terrier type, good head, wicked eye, enough bone for size, just needs time, handled well.

3. Gardner & Twyman's
Laronbelle's Magic Visions.

Post Graduate Dog (5 Entries, 3 Absent) 1. Marples' **Taylajay Look No Further.**

Liked him a lot, his handler always gets the best out of him, beautiful head, filled and turned, beautiful bodylines, excellent bone, strong quarters, gleaming coat.

2. Atkins' **Hentarw Executive Decision.**
Another good dog, in lovely condition, good head, excellent rounded bone, deep chest, moved OK.

Limit Dog (3 Entries, 0 Absent) 1. Williams & Hawksford's **Busells Red Knight Rising.** A lot to like about this dog, fabulous head, filled and beautiful finish, keen expression, good bodylines, strong quarters, enough bone for his size. 2. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Berties Brother.**

Powerful, well made dog, good strong head, good earset, deep chest, strong quarters, moved with drive, handler does him proud.
3. Martin & Hirst's **Bullyview Moment Of Madness At Santini.**

Open Dog (5 Entries, 2 Absent) 1. Pilkington's **Ch. Jerjes Bull De Cabanas At Javarke.** Worthy Champion, good head not over exaggerated, good mouth, neat ears, strong neck and topline, well put down in gleaming condition. The CC winner is a young stallion, the finished package and the RDCC is typy and compact and he has just that little bit more length of leg than the OD winner. Three top class dogs. 2. Morgan's **Marshelsea Trouble Coming At Romagna.**

Puppy Bitch (5 Entries, 2 Absent) 1. Galla's **Vetsbullies Happiness.** Very pretty feminine r/w, well made bitch, clean head, excellent keen expression, well developed length of neck, good rounded bone, powerful quarters, in excellent show condition and handled well. 2. Mathison's **Blazinbullys Lady Mizfitz.** Another very feminine typy bitch, excellent head finished well, good reach of neck, nicely rounded bone, liked her bodylines, handled very well. 3. Ironmonger's **Bullyview Snow Flake Britanic.**

Junior Bitch (1 Entry, 0 Absent) 1. Dynes & McGeown's **Debully Devine Vision At Barbulls.** Very pretty bitch of quality, classical head, good expression, enough bone and handler worked hard with her.

Novice Bitch (1 Entry, 0 Absent) 1. White's **Shanthana Thai Black Orchid.** Mature coloured bitch, good head and exceptionally clean teeth, well rounded bone, liked her compact bodylines.

Post Graduate Bitch (5 Entries, 1 Absent) 1. Brown's **Tulsadom Terrys All Gold.** Quality typy bitch who really made her handler work hard. Pleasing head, good reach of neck, good bodylines. Not liking the conditions here but she is a very nice bitch. 2. L'Homme's **Goodbye To Helen Wheels.** Mature white, enough head, keen expression, excellent bodylines, sound quarters, handled well, in good show condition. 3. Mills' **Simbatahill Tell Tale Lass.**

Limit Bitch (3 Entries, 1 Absent) 1. Konings & Berez's **Action Hot And Classy.** **Bitch Reserve CC** Quality bitch and so typy, has a lovely head filled and nicely finished, keen expression, elegant neck and beautiful bodylines, sound quarters, in immaculate condition and handler shows her quietly and with confidence. 2. Taylor & Sheppard's **Bullywood Avenging Star To Ragnarok.** Another typy white, pretty head, good ears which she used well. Not quite the substance of 1 but a nice girl.

Open Bitch (5 Entries, 1 Absent) 1. Fletcher's **Napier Mary Jane.** **Bitch CC** This is no 'plain Jane', a real stunner and I believe her first Championship Show, mature and still very feminine, powerful head, good reach of neck, excellent bone, compact body and good topline kept on the move. CC, pressed hard for BOB, expertly handled. 2. Young's **Ch. Polaris Bull De Cabanas At Bullyview.** Quality bitch, worthy Champion, good head filled and turned, excellent bodylines, strong quarters. Her coat let her down slightly. 3. Bloom & O'Neill's **Kholander Tropicana At Abenaki.**
