DOGS

Being their 70th Anniversary year, it felt very special to be asked to judge.

Puppy Dog

1. Cambridge & Jerome's **Ounsdale**

Return Of The Mac For Elysianplain.

10 months b/br, beautiful head, well filled with power, excellent eye and ear placement gives typical expression, well developed forechest, compact body, short back and nice amount of bone, correct bend of stifle, powerful quarters with good tailset, stands on round tight feet, moved with drive from behind.

Toes in a little in front, needs to tighten at the elbow. In good condition and well handled.

2. Malden's **Louka Kolor Koded.**

10 months b/br, different type to 1, half white face, good eye and ear. Not quite the power and fill of 1. Elegant neck leading to good front and shoulder, with nicely developed forechest, enough bone for size and good feet, longer cast than winner. Good body lines, powerful quarters, moved OK behind. A little wide in front, would like a little more bend of stifle.

Novice Dog

1. Sheehy's **Fortifer's Fire Foot For Afanbull.**

Tall solid red dog, gorgeous head with profile, punishing expression from excellent eye and ear, strong underjaw, beautiful straight front leading to good shoulder and neck. Enough bone for size, good feet, short backed, well made dog who held his topline, quarters had correct angulation and tailset, movement was fair, a dog I have admired from the ring side on many occasions. Would like a little more fill under the eye. Very well presented and handled.

2. Binks' **Jayston White Warrior.**

Mature white dog, standing very square, gentle profile with finish and a good dark eye. Ears a little soft, excellent shoulders, front and chest, a powerfully built boy excelling in bone, beautifully tight round feet, very short backed with a solid topline, gently rising over the loin to the quarters which are powerfully made, tail is set on correctly. Moved soundly but would like to see more drive from such a powerfully built dog. Shown well and in good hard condition.

Junior Dog

1. McDermid's **Padhen Hitman.**

Best Dog & Best In Show

13 months b/br dog, caught my eye as soon as he entered, beautifully

balanced and in pristine condition, a very smart looking dog of moderate size, beautiful head with profile and fill, his colour deceives until you get up close, excellent eye and well set neat ears, elegant neck leads to well made straight front and well developed forechest, has enough bone for size and stands on good round feet, short backed with an excellent topline and tailset. Would like a little more power in the quarters, but this should come with age and maturity with the right exercise. Movement was good in front, a little close behind at this stage. Shown and handled very well.

2. Seward's **Padhen The Puzzler.**

Litter brother to 1, but a different type. Well marked br/w with a powerful well filled head, correct profile and good eye and ear, good straight front, leading to nice shoulders, mature forechest and short back, ample bone. Would like a little more arch to the toes. Rear is powerful and well angulated, with tail well set on. Moved a little close behind and topline not held on the move. Overall an honest dog.

Post Graduate Dog

1. Kettleborough's **Bullysoul To Hard To Handle.**

Mature br/w dog, very tpy with lovely fill and expression, good profile with finish and enough power, excellent ear placement, beautifully made front, gun barrel chest, excellent feet, would like a touch more bone. Shortest of backs with a solid topline when standing, well developed quarters. Moved close behind and a little wide at the front, lacking a little in drive.

Limit Dog

1. Roberts' **Teirwgwyn Head Banger.**

Reserve Best Dog

Lively and mature quality white dog, short powerful head with finish, good eye and ear, though reluctant to use the latter. Correct profile and filled right up, good neck into deep chest with good foreleg and nice amount of bone, feet tight enough, back is short, topline firm and leads to very powerful quarters which he uses when moving to give his handler a trying time! Needed a firm hand and eventually settled enough to see his movement was true. Shown with some patience and expertise by his very experienced handler.

2. Blair's **Taylajay Highflyer Into Megaville.**

All male heavyweight br/w, very well marked with a rich deep colour, screams masculinity, huge amount of bone, well developed chest and body, big deep brisket and short back. Lovely well muscled rear quarters, outstanding feet which are arched and tight and round, head is wide with a well set ear and good eye. Would prefer a tad more profile to complete the picture. Moved with drive, positively pounded down the mat, though a little close behind. A very useful dog if used correctly.

Open Dog

1. Keeble's **Grazami Rambo's Son Of Honour.**

Mature white dog, good head with

excellent eye and ear giving typical expression. Would like a bit more under the eye. Good profile and powerful underjaw, elegant neck, straight front, enough bone for size, feet are tight and round, chest deep and leads to good ribs, in good condition, with a well muscled rear, tail is set on correctly, moved well once he got into his stride, holding his topline throughout.

2. Hammill's **The Priest.**

Medium sized white, fully mature dog with brindle eye patch, gentle profile with a slight break. A fabulous temperament. Reluctant to use his ears as the happy ones often are, lacks a little in fill and power. Good shoulders and a huge deep chest, enough bone leads to nice feet, pasterns a little weak. Stocky boy with a short back and good rear. Carries tail high but it is set on correctly, movement was wide in front and a little close behind, would like to see him a little more stream lined.

Veteran

1. Haase's **Bavazuela Ingemar Joh.**

7 years white dog, in excellent condition, good ear and eye, still holding typical expression, head has a gentle profile, lovely neck into good clean shoulder, nice amount of bone and tight round feet, short backed dog, still nicely muscled with a powerful rear. Was a reluctant show man when younger but seems to enjoy his day now he is older. Moved OK when settled, well handled and congratulations for keeping him looking very fit and well.

BITCHES

Brood

1. Martin & Hirst's **Yungwood Sweet Enchantment At Santini.**

This br/w bitch has a beautiful head, very feminine with a good profile, lovely ears well placed, lovely long neck and good bone. Would like a little more forechest. Nice spring of ribs and lovely rear angulation, her movement was OK both ways.

2. Jerome's **Hardysview Miss Cerberus For Elysianplain.**

White bitch with eye patch, super head with power, profile and great expression, good bone and lovely feet, moves well both ways. Topline drops on the move.

Puppy Bitch

1. Patterson's **Golitha Gittering Prize.**

Best Puppy, Best Bitch & Reserve Best In Show

Just loved this young girl as soon as I saw her, 9 months white with super head, just power packed with profile, good ear placement, lovely neck. Nicely tucked in elbows and nice tight feet with good bone, short backed, well muscled rear and good angulation, good movement coming and going.

2. Malden's **Louka Frosty Lady.**

10 months white bitch, nice head with a good eye and ear. Would like a little more power and underjaw. Good shoulders and good bone, lovely tight feet and had a lovely body shape, very good movement both ways.

Novice Bitch

1. Binks' **Bullbrit Scream.**

Very feminine b/br/w, nice head with lovely deep underjaw and super ear placement, lovely eye, good front with a lovely deep chest and solid topline, movement was good both ways, I really liked this girl.

2. Wilkins' **Albaeda Dolly Dagger.**

Beautiful white bitch with a red ear, good head and a lovely expression, nice deep chest, a big powerful girl with lots of bone and good feet, moved OK when she settled.

Junior Bitch

1. Godsall's **Albaeda Singing The Blues For Neverland.**

This white bitch with brindle ear has a super powerful head with good expression. Nice ears but did not like using them. Snug canines, good reach of neck with straight front and lovely deep chest. Good tight feet and ample bone. Moved better coming than going.

2. Coverdale's **Ukusa Jubilee.**

R/w bitch, lovely power filled head with a good eye and tiny ears, good catlike feet and lovely bone. Would like more length of leg, movement OK.

Post Graduate Bitch

1. Fitzherbert & Stewart's **Ounsdale Mighty Medusa.**

Very pretty br/w bitch, lovely profile with good eye and nice ear placement, super reach of neck leads to a lovely deep chest, lots of bone, movement good and shows herself all the time.

2. Sheehy's **Wellinghall Taylor Maid For Afanbull.**

White bitch, super head both deep and powerful, lovely neck and short backed, very lady-like bitch, movement OK. Lost topline on the move.

Limit Bitch

1. O'Connell's **Elvroc Who Dares Wins At Koellen.**

White bitch with a power packed head, lovely deep underjaw and good ear placement, nice shoulders and good front with nice forechest, short backed and good bone. Moved slightly wide at the front.

2. Malden's **Louka Madam Mischief.**

White bitch with a long head, I'd like more power. Lovely expression and lovely ears bang on top, nice long neck and good shoulders, short backed with good rear angulation. Movement better coming than going.

Open Bitch

1. Sheehy's **Wellinghall Ebony Nugget For Afanbull.**

Reserve Best Bitch

Beautiful b/br/w bitch, power packed head with lovely eye and great ear placement, deep underjaw with a super profile, good bone, tight feet, movement good. Topline could be better.
