The Yorkshire Bull Terrier Club held its September Open Show which included Miniature Bull Terrier classes. This combined Show was an enjoyable and innovative way to increase both the interest and number of entries.

I was particularly pleased to see only a couple of severe mouth faults. Presentation in general was good and temperaments throughout were excellent.

Puppy Dog (2 Entries)

1. Parkes & Burridge's **Chardaice Dillinger**.
Good sized r/w, 11 month old, nicely marked, good strong head, good straight front with tight feet, compact shapely body with short back and good quarters. Just a little unsettled at times which showed in his movement but obviously still only a youngster. In good condition, a promising young dog seriously considered for BP in the challenge.

2. Martindale's **Chicos Ice Legacy**.
White with eye and ear mark, head slightly plain but a well made young dog, good bone and substance, presented well. Movement a little erratic and he just lacked the overall quality of 1 and I believe shown for the first time.

Novice Dog (2 Entries)

1. Tinkler's **Danbull Dark Diablo**.
Substantial well marked b/br, good strong head with a couple of teeth out of place. Nice straight front. Feet a little untidy, compact body and decent hindquarters. Moved a little loose in the front and close behind. In good condition and had the personality to go with it.

2. Mortlock's **Sunny Enter Sandman**.
Br/w, good head, shoulder and front, well made with good feet and in nice condition and well marked. Little lethargic and didn't have the animation of 1 and could have done with a bit more weight to help complete the picture.

Post Graduate Dog (3 Entries)

1. Hammill's **The Priest**.
Good sized white, pleasing head with a brindle eye patch, slight mouth fault. Well made with a shapely body although a little stuffy through the neck which spoils his outline. Good hindquarters and moved reasonably well both ways.

2. Laycock's **Casodon Smooth Criminal**.

Substantial white with an elegant but slightly plain head but needs more strength and turn to it. Well proportioned dog with the correct amount of bone for his size, moved OK.

Limit Dog (3 Entries)

1. Kettleborough's **Bullsoul To Hard To Handle**.

Best Dog & Reserve Best In Show
Attractive and beautifully marked br/w dog, classical head without any exaggeration with a good front, nice tight feet leading into a strong body with the right amount of bone and substance for his size, good quarters but being critical would like to see a bit more bend of stifle which showed slightly in his rear movement. A very pleasing dog on the eye and standing looked a picture, shown and presented in very good condition and a credit to his owner.

Open Dog (5 Entries)

1. Gardner & Patterson's **Javarke Sharp Shooter At Angliphorde**.
Attractively marked br/w dog with decent head and good mouth, is well made although his front feet were a little untidy with a compact body. Good bone and hindquarters, moved reasonably well but a little close behind. A smart looking coloured dog who was presented well.

2. Keeble's **Grazami Rambo's Son Of Honour**.

Much larger heavier made white dog with a pleasing head with a mouth fault. Powerfully made body with good width and depth to it, good bone, just a little erratic on the move.

3. Mortlock's **Sunny Enter Sandman**.

Puppy Bitch (8 Entries)

This was by far the best overall class of the day with a nice line-up of young bitches of varying colours and type with really not a great deal between them all.

1. Wannop's **Maggie's Beautiful Lady Via Charishalee**.

Best Puppy
Eye-catching elegant white with red head mark, lovely sweeping head in profile with a keen expression and good mouth. Ears could be a little closer. Correct front with nice shoulders leading into a feminine shapely body with enough substance and bone for her size, good strong hindquarters for age and moved well both in front and behind. Being critical perhaps a bit more width to her skull and slightly shorter in back would complete the picture but nevertheless a quality young bitch shown and presented well.

2. Binks' **Darling Treasure**.

White with two brindle ears marks, very well made bitch with a short compact body and bone to match, just not the head and overall presence of 1. Moved reasonably well both ways.

3. Keeble's **Ebullient I Made It**.

Junior Bitch (7 Entries)

1. Carrick's **Bullbrand Bonnie Not Clyde At Heavensway**.

Smart r/w with a nicely turned and filled head, good mouth, good front section, feet were tight enough but her nails were slightly too long spoiling the overall look of her feet. Short compact body with good hindquarters, moved well, a well balanced feminine bitch throughout.

2. Wilson's **Alizarin Sugar Babe**.

Big substantial white with brindle head mark, good strong head with a good mouth but needs more turn and fill, ears a little loose. Good straight front and shapely enough in body but just a little loose all round and erratic on the move but still moved reasonably well. I just preferred the overall compactness and type of 1.

3. Fox's **Danbull Cauzin Chaos At Kraydenbull**.

Maiden Bitch (0 Entries)

Novice Bitch (1 Entry)

1. Quinn & Seward's **Padhen Pearls Princess**.

Smart compact br/w, pleasing head with good mouth, needs more turn and fill. Good front, decent feet, body compact and short with decent quarters, moved OK in front and slightly close behind. Attractive coloured bitch in good condition and calmly handled.

Post Graduate Bitch (3 Entries)

1. Wright & Skelton's **Joint Venture With Rightstuff**.

Best Of Breed & Best In Show

Very smart white with a good turned and filled head with expression to match, couple of misplaced teeth. Standing she presents a beautiful outline, is made extremely well with a good front, shoulder placement, neck and the short strong compact body with strong well developed hindquarters. Bit of a handful on the move but she can move. An eye-catching quality bitch who is balanced and combines the right amount of power and femininity, she is maturing and coming into her own now.

2. Hammill's **Tiapan Starlight Express**.
Big substantial heavyweight white with two brindle ears, lovely strong head, well made throughout although perhaps a little overweight. Just lacked interest, moved reasonably well both ways.

Limit Bitch (3 Entries)

1. Favill's **Padhen Pandoras Box At Krawen**.

Well marked br/w with a pretty feminine head and good mouth, would like to have seen a little more strength and turn to it. Well put together, nice feet, good straight front, well placed shoulders, good length to back, good hindquarters, moved reasonably well both ways, presented and showed well.

2. Pleasants' **Casodon Yorkshire Orchid**.

Big substantial white with eye patch,

strong head which needs more fill and turn to it. Bags of bone and substance to match her size, fairly well made throughout although perhaps a little long in the back, moved OK.

Open Bitch (6 Entries)

1. Woolliss' **Tiapan Skywriter**.

Good sized white with small head and ear mark, good head which is strong, turned and filled with a good mouth, generally well made throughout with decent feet, moved OK when she got going.

2. Favill's **Padhen Pandora's Box At Krawen**.

Miniature Bull Terriers

All the Miniatures were healthy with gleaming coats; it should be noted the whites had no need of chalk to enhance their beauty. The entry was large for a Club Show, 18 with 6 absentees; the Open Bitch line-up would have graced any Championship Show including Crufts.

Junior Dog or Bitch (6 Entries)

1. Presland & Vincent's **Kofyn Klick Of The Light**.

Best Puppy & Reserve Best Dog
9 months white dog, under measure, good head and expression, used small ears well, excellent mouth, short back, good rear movement. Front loose, should improve. Lovely temperament.

2. Vickers' **Duversa Delicia**.

14 months solid brindle bitch, very pretty, under measure, phenomenal head with superb expression, smallest of ears bang on top, good shoulders and front, moved well with jaunty attitude. Her cross is a bad mouth which cost her 1.

Open Dog (4 Entries)

1. Vickers' **Duversa King Charisma**.

Best Of Breed
13 month white dog, very mature, on the measure, excellent head with superb expression, perfect mouth, small ears used well, well made, moved well showing his happy 'cocky' attitude.

2. Dandridge's **Warbonnet Andretti At Ropodandy**.

5 years br/w, over measure, good head and expression, perfect mouth well made and moved accordingly. Lacks confidence in the ring but is a real gentleman.

Open Bitch (8 Entries)

1. Vickers' **Devil Wears Prada**.

Best Bitch
Solid brindle, under measure, feminine, and wonderful temperament, excellent head and expression, perfect mouth, small ears, good neck, slightly long cast, moved well.

2. Jarvis & Thornley's **Seaquest Warrior Maiden**.

White, under measure, very feminine, well made, good head and expression, mouth fault, short back, moves very well, happy show temperament.
