Exhibitors had pleasingly good temperaments, the fundamental virtue of this breed. However, some worryingly common construction faults, particularly very short upper arms, marred several otherwise very good specimens; very short upper arms take away those 'bay windows' which are such a feature of well constructed dogs.

We also seem to be losing the breadth and length of foreface, which, together with wide lower jaws are essential to good dentition. As ever, movements were less than inspiring but with a few pleasing exceptions: notably the main winners, particularly the two CC winners which moved very well, the better mover achieving BOB (and Group 3).

Puppy Dog (2 Entries, 1 Absent)
1. Wright's **RIGHTSTUFF REFLECT A BULL.**
Best Puppy

White with dark head mark, butterfly nose, nicely balanced dog with enough bone, good bodylines for age, nice profile, correct mouth, well placed eyes and ears, would like wider muzzle, straight front but a bit short in upper arm, correct tailset, moved well for age, immature but promising.

Junior Dog (2 Entries, 1 Absent)
1. Nelson's **BILBOEN YANNIS.**
Well boned tri-colour, nicely balanced though better tail carriage would improve. Powerful head with well placed eyes and fairly good ears, scissor bite but one canine tight. Straight front spoilt by turning toes out a little, good quarters, movement fairly good, a tad close behind.

Post Graduate Dog (2 Entries, 0 Absent)
1. Grant, Parkes & Burridge's **CHARDAICE DILLINGER.**
Red and white fairly well marked, curved profile with correct bite, would like ears more on top, greater width of muzzle and fill under the eyes, moved fairly well though a bit close behind.
2. Quentin's **G'S VAUDDHU DES PIRATES D'ORTHO.**
Nicely marked brindle and white, well boned, straight front and fairly good body lines, head has lovely profile with slanting eyes, ears fairly good. Needs better width of muzzle and lower jaw, lower left canine misplaced, straight front, movement fairly good.

Limit Dog (10 Entries, 4 Absent)
1. Pullen's **LOUKA GONE RACIN'.**
Dog Reserve CC
Black, brindle and white, nicely marked, powerful head with lovely profile and marked roman finish, well placed eyes, would like ears a bit more on top, scissor bite, stands foursquare with pleasing bodylines including well set tail, good movement both ways. Quality dog.
2. Newberry's **UKUSA QUAGMIRE.**
Short backed white dog, outline spoiled by tail carriage. Head with good profile and eyes, average ear placement, scissor bite, movement fairly good though rather close behind.
3. Williams & Hawksford's **BUSELL'S RED KNIGHT RISING.**
RES. Jerome & Cambridge's **OUNSDALE RETURN OF THE MAC AT ELYSIANPLAIN.**
VHC. Keeble's **GRAZAMI RAMBO'S SON OF HONOUR.**

Open Dog (5 Entries, 0 Absent)
1. McDermaid's **PADHEN HITMAN.**
Dog CC
Black, brindle and white, powerful well boned dog, well balanced, good bodylines and horizontal tail carriage, head has curved profile and well placed eyes giving pleasing expression, ears better than average but still not quite on top, scissor bite, very good movement with reach and drive. To be supercritical I would like more length and breadth of foreface, but all told this is a top class dog, easily taking DCC.
2. Wannop & Crossan's **SON OF LEGENDS.**
White, straight front and good bodylines spoilt by rather flat front feet and I would like more muscle in quarters. Good head with curved profile and lovely eyes giving pleasing expression marred by low set ears, slightly undershot, fairly good movement.
3. Lamonby's **EMRED DEVILS SPY.**
Res. Griffiths' **HENTARW WELSH WARRIOR FROM PENPYCH.**
VHC. Newberry's **HELLSBOY BY UKUSA.**

Puppy Bitch (1 Entry, 0 Absent)
1. Morgans' **ROMAGNA DRAMA QUEEN.**
Nicely marked brindle and white, curved profile with good length of foreface and correct bite. Very reluctant to show or move, I was told she had just been sick before entering the ring and she was later withdrawn from further competition following more regurgitations of lumps of wood.

Junior Bitch (7 Entries, 1 Absent)
1. Phillips' **BULLYON IMEASUREABULL NESS.**
Bitch Reserve CC
Attractive white, nicely balanced construction with pleasing topline and well carried tail, quality head with curved profile, small eyes and

quite good ear carriage giving good expression, scissor bite. One of the better movers, flat feet spoil the picture a bit, but a quality bitch.
2. Grieves' **TEIRWGWYN MISS INDEPENDANT OF MEILOW.**
Attractive and well presented tri-colour, a well built elegant bitch, long arched neck, lovely topline and tail carriage but spoiled by a short upper arm. Lovely head with good eyes, ears, profile and scissor bite. The upper arm reduces her reach but otherwise good movement.
3. Redmond's **WARHORSE DEATH OR GLORY.**
Res. Llewellyn's **EMRED BLUEBELL GIRL BULLYPINS.**
VHC. Ball's **EMRED HELLS ANGEL AT FIRECOMMAND.**

Post Graduate Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)
1. Wilson & Stephens' **ALIZARIN SUGAR BABE.**
White with brindle eye patch, straight front, good quarters and correct tail carriage. A smoother topline would improve. Nicely curved head, correct mouth, decent eyes and ears, moved with drive though a little close behind, nice bitch.

Limit Bitch (7 Entries, 2 Absent)
1. Foster's **BILBOEN X-RATED.**
Bitch CC, Best Of Breed & Group 3
Nicely marked red and white, pleasing bodylines and topline, well balanced, strong head gently turned and fairly good earset, scissor bite, reasonable length and breadth of muzzle, her good construction resulted in her demonstrating much the best movement of the day, parallel and with real reach and drive, a pleasure to watch.
2. L'Homme's **GOODBYE TO HELEN WHEELS AT KAISERBULL.**
Good head with nice profile, lovely eyes and good earset, correct bite, straight front with good quarters and tail set, moved fairly well both ways.
3. Binks' **DARLING TREASURE.**
Res. Leggatt's **DIKRAMS BLACK MAGIC AT RABRAM.**
VHC. Read's **SEASONS IN THE SUN.**

Open Bitch (2 Entries, 0 Absent)
1. Ley & Broomfield's **FORTIFER'S FLAMMETA.**
Red and white, strong filled head with curved profile, good eyes, ears almost on top, good depth of muzzle but teeth slightly undershot, smooth topline, correct tailset, slightly short in upper arm and turns front toes out a little, average movement.
2. Brown's **TULSADOOM TERRY'S ALL GOLD.**
White with brindle ear patch, substantial bitch, slightly upright in front largely due to short upper arm. Good quarters and tail carriage, head has pleasing expression, mouth just correct, lower jaw rather narrow, adequate movement.
