Thank you to the Blackpool Committee for inviting me to do my first Championship Show for Bull Terriers in the UK. I was happy to see the sun shine and the rain clouds disappear as the day went on. It was a lovely day for the Show, cool and slightly overcast, perfect for man and beast!

Thank you to my able ring steward Russell Lamonby and a special thanks to those who exhibited their lovely dogs under me. There were some very close decisions and each dog was presented fit for function and well prepared for the ring.

Puppy Dog (2 Entries, 0 Absent) 1. Rae's **Irazistabull Star Of Hades. Best Puppy**

Dark brindle dog that is up on leg. Has a wonderful turned head and super profile. Fill under the eye is also decent. He could use a bit more width of muzzle. Expression could be a bit keener but eye placement is very good. Nice pert ears that he used well. Bite is slightly off. Nice straight front with tight feet. Fore chest needs to drop. His bone is adequate. Viewed from the side his neck flows into a good top line. Shoulder could use a bit more layback. Moved well in all directions. Should mature into very nice dog indeed.

2. Wright's **Rightstuff Reflect A Bull.**

White dog with lots of bone and substance. A cobby specimen with much to offer. Very good head with plenty of fill, good eye with keen expression, ears right on top and used well. Glad to be here and showed it by being a bit of an 'excitable boy'. Moved well in front, could improve in rear.

Junior Dog (4 Entries, 0 Absent) 1. Woodward's **Gorbain Hellboy. Dog Reserve CC**

A very substantial white dog with a powerful head and good bite with regular strong teeth. Punishing expression and animated ears. His head has super strength with a bit of a brow from profile. Viewed from front his chest is well developed and dropped. Super bone, good feet and front. Side on he is short backed and muscular with chest well below his

elbow. Top line held well on the move and he came and went well with drive from the side. A very masculine dog with a brawny physique for a young dog. Living up to his name with his handler!

2. Potter's **Maximus White Knight At Topfuel.**

Another white dog that is very typy, cobby. His head is also very good, filled and full down to the muzzle with a good bite. Eye a bit more open than dog number one. Good ear set. Side view shows a short back and proper rise over loin. Front a bit more 'Bull' than Terrier when viewed front on but still moved well coming in, a bit close going away.

3. Leggatt & Pilkington's **Javarke Karbon Kopy.**

Res. Dyson's **Gorbain Hellraiser Tawnbarr.**

Limit Dog (5 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Blair's **Taylajay Dream A Lie At Megaville.**

White dog with black ears. Impressive bone and substance for his size. Classical head with no dips or hollows. Smooth throughout. Bite good, ears could be set more upright on his head which would improve all over keenness of expression. Viewed front on he is substantial and stands well over himself. Feet are tight. Side view shows a neck that flows to well laid shoulder and decent length of back. Moved bullish coming and a bit close going away. All in all a very nice dog. Close call between this dog and the RDCC dog.

2. Williams & Hawksford's **Busell's Red Knight Rising.**

Solid red dog with plenty to like. Nicely filled head with turn and pack and good expression Scissors bite. Straight front and small feet with good bone. Short enough in back and moved well fore, aft and from the side.

3. Keeble's **Grazami Rambo's Son Of Honour.**

Res. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Bertie's Brother.**

Open Dog (4 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. McDermid's **Ch. Padhen Hitman. Dog CC & Best Of Breed**

Black brindle dog of immense quality. Head is classically filled and turned with a smooth feel under the hand showing no dips or hollows. Bite is spot on. Could use a keener expression. Ears are well set on top of his head. This dog shines in body construction. Ramrod front and nice feet and decent forechest when viewed from front. Side view shows upright pasterns and brisket well below elbows, which are nicely tucked in. Smooth neck flows into excellent shoulder assembly and leads to short back with a slight rise over the loin. Stifles well bent and turned with short hocks. Movement is excellent in all directions. Black jacket gleams.

2. Wannop & Crossan's **Son Of Legends.**

A powerful white dog with lots of virtues. His head is nicely filled with a well turned profile. Tiny eyes give him an evil expression. Mouth is a bit off. Deep chest from front and side. Good front. Cobby dog with a short back and top line that holds on the move. Went around the ring well in all directions.

Puppy Bitch (3 Entries, 2 Absent) 1. Young's **Bullyview Sweet Memories.**

Lovely little white girl carrying red. Nicely filled up head with profile turned right over. Expression is excellent. Pert ears which she used well. Front is good but pasterns turn out a bit at toes. Well made and moved as well as can be expected of a young one. A bit more bone would complete the picture.

Junior Bitch (6 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Phillips' **Bullyon Imeasureabull Ness.**

Bitch Reserve CC

Striking white bitch who takes your eye with her elegant silhouette. Head is turned and she has sweeping body lines from neck to tail. Elbows are well tucked in and brisket falls below them. Forechest is prominent and top line is smooth. Well turned rear. Front on she does not disappoint with well filled head and good expression. Front could be better at the feet and a tad more bone for her size would be advantageous. Coming in she is parallel. Her cross to bear is her rear movement which is very close.

2. Grieves' **Teirwgwyn Miss Independent Of Meilow.**

A gorgeous upstanding tri who gave the winner of this class a run for her money. On any day either could win. Again, from the side a striking figure of a Bull Terrier with a beautiful head and lovely neck and shoulders and strong rear. Her bite is perfect and her head has enough fill to match a turned over head. Her handler was in sync with her and moved her well. Two very nice bitches.

3. Llewellyn's **Emred Bluebell Girl Bullypins.**

Res. **Thain's Debully Dee Dee.**

Post Graduate Bitch (6 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Jastrzebska's **Tinkle Bell Timar.**

Classic little white bitch with a good head. Perhaps a bit more profile would be desired but a wonderfully filled up muzzle. Tiny ears right on top and super expression. Very short and cobby. Gorgeous straight front and excellent feet, short back. Movement was super. A lively bitch exhibiting true Bull Terrier type.

2. Marples' **Japulcas Secret Charm At Taylajay.**

Silvery brindle with a very good head, profile and super expression. Lovely

outline that needs a better shoulder layback and depth of chest. Good bone. Shoulder assembly makes for a bit of extra length of back but a very nice animal that moved well.

3. Egan & Cusick's **Lady Muskattelle Credetta.**

Res. Crowe & Carlin's **Duffield's Secret Angel.**

Limit Bitch (4 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Galla's **Vetsbullies Happiness.**

Powerful red bitch who would have won the movement trophy if there had been one. She was true fore, aft, from the side and in between, a pleasure to watch her. Along with this attribute she also has a lovely head, lots of bone, straight front and strong forechest. A shorter back would complete the picture.

2. Williams & Hawksford's **Bobuddy Evanesence.**

White, tall, statuesque bitch that also has a lovely outline and a long dramatic head that could use a bit more fill. She has a very nice shoulder. From the front she could use a bit more bone down near her feet. Moved well in front, closer behind.

3. Wilson & Stephens' **Alizarin Sugar Babe.**

Res. Wright & Skelton's **Joint Venture With Rightstuff.**

Open Bitch (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Konings & Berez' **Am Ch. Action Hot And Classy.**

Bitch CC

White bitch that exudes type. Head is filled and turned with wicked little eyes. Good bite. Ears could be a bit stronger although they are well set. Profile sweeps from top of head to tip of nose. Front on elbows are tucked in and her front is straight save a slight turn out on the left foot. Excellent bone from top to bottom. Side view allows for a deep brisket and flowing neck and shoulder leading to strong top line with rise over loin. Powerful rear. Although a bit erratic on the move it was enough to see she is good in all directions. She is rock hard and muscular under your hands and in tip top condition.

2. Young's **Bullyview Gansta's Girl.**

Lovely white bitch that is just the opposite of the winner, short and cobby. Gorgeous head turned right over, bite slightly off. Super expression. Good front with toes turned slightly out. Powerful forechest. Strong and powerful rear assembly. Moved well even though she was in full season. A lovely animal.
