I would like to thank the Bull Terrier Club of Wales committee for inviting me to judge this Show and for the hospitality shown to me on the day. Also a big thank you to the 56 entries that I received, you all made my day.

Overall I was very happy with the quality of dogs shown under me and would happily take a few home. Bitches were stronger than dogs in depth as always seems to be the case.

Puppy Dog

1. Kilpatrick's **Wild Heart Opalpast** (TAF).

Best Puppy & Reserve Best Dog

Upstanding white dog with black brindle ear of 10 months old. Pleasing well filled head, the tinniest of eye with correct ear placement giving a punishing expression. Perfect mouth with big white teeth. Good reach of neck leading into well placed shoulders and a good front. Good bone, big rear end with a good bend of stifle. Moved well both ways and with drive from behind. Feet could be better.

2. Cserfalvi-Young's **Ducassos Red Ocre**.

11 month old red and white terrier. Long well filled head with good profile, good mouth, shoulder was correct. Good bone for size going into tidy feet, well angulated rear end, movement was a little loose and topline was lost on the move.

Junior Dog

1. Smalley's **Briden Backchat**.

Best Dog & Best In Show

White dog of 17 months with black brindle ear. Cobby type of dog with an excellent head, plenty of width, filled up to the maximum and with profile, very good ear set and a very good eye lead to a first class expression on this boy. His mouth is just off his K9's are correct. Short backed muscular dog that has good bone and good feet, moved well both ways. Happy to give him BD & BIS.

2. Hilling's **Chardaice Fist Of Fury**. Brindle and white 17 month old dog with a good profile and enough width. Slight mouth fault, I would like to see him use his ears more. Nice lay of shoulder, good round

bone although front feet could be tighter. A well angulated rear end which showed in his movement once he settled. Shown well.

3. Johnson's **Bronygarn Bow Street Runner**.

Post Graduate Dog

1. Tudor's **Ukusa Fire Demon**.

Upstanding red and white dog, long head with a slight break in profile could use more width. Decent ears, mouth level. Good bone leading into excellent feet, laid back dog.

Limit Dog

1. Jerome & Cambridge's **Ounsdale Return Of The Mac At Elysianplain**.

Black brindle dog with a pleasing head, filled up and with a good profile. Correct eye and well placed ears give a good expression, good round bone for size, short in back and a correct mouth. Moved well both ways and in hard muscled condition which just won him the class.

2. Evans' **Bronygarn Bold As Brass**.

Tri-coloured male, deep head that has profile and fill, correct mouth and good ears, well made dog, nice reach of neck going into a good front and shoulders. Good bone and good tight feet. Moved well when settled, coat in excellent condition.

Open Dog

1. Joshua's **Bronygarn Prince Of Thieves**.

White dog with two black brindle ears, good headed dog that has profile width and fill. Good eye and a good mouth. Heavy round bone into decent feet, short backed muscular dog. Big powerful rear end, topline is not good.

2. Pullen's **Louka Gone Racin'**.

Black brindle dog, gentle profile with a good finish, enough fill for head, eye a little round, good bone, coat in good condition, moved very well on the day.

Veteran Dog or Bitch

1. Waycott's **Fortifer Not Before Noon At Waybully**.

9½ year old white bitch, deep chest on her, good bone and feet, rear end is very well angulated. Nicely made bitch who moved well for her age, in good condition and a credit to her owner.

Puppy Bitch

1. Smalley's **Ducassos Harlequin Of Briden**.

Brindle and white bitch 11 months old. Small typy bitch who is well made, very good profile though I wouldn't want any more, wide head that is filled right up. Very good eye and ear carriage giving an excellent

expression, mouth is correct, good bone for her type, tight cat feet. In very good hard condition. Movement was OK made her handler work hard today.

2. Malden's **Louka Special Lady**. White bitch of 11 months old. Nice typy bitch who is well made, I would like a little more profile, enough width and fill for her type, good eye, correct ear set giving a good expression. Decent bone and feet, coat out of condition today.

Junior Bitch

1. Thomas' **Bronygarn Bobby's Girl At Mostahbull**.

Best Bitch & Best Opposite Sex

White bitch with two brindle ears, very good head with plenty of width and fill enough profile. Perfect mouth with big white teeth. Heavy set square bitch with excellent round bone and tight feet. Good spring of rib and a big well angulated rear end. Moved well and with drive and kept her topline. In excellent condition. Front a little loose. Not many bitches of this type about sadly. Happy to give her Best Bitch.

2. Smalley's **Briden Summer Breeze**.

Pretty feminine white bitch with two black brindle ears/eyes. Very good profile and fill, decent shoulder and front, short backed, good round bone into tight feet, well angulated rear end. Movement was good at front a little close behind, one canine incorrect.

Post Graduate Bitch

1. George's **Taylajay I Dreamed The Dream**.

Pretty white terrier type bitch with two small tri eye marks, very nice head with good profile and fill, small neat ears that are well placed, plenty of bone for type, good shoulder placement. Well angulated rear end, good mouth, moved well but just loses topline on the move.

2. Cserfalvi-Young's **Ducassos Proud Mary**.

All white bitch with a good head. Nice profile with good fill, well made, good lay of shoulder and good bone and an excellent spring of rib. Good rear angulation, moved pretty well, feet could be better.

3. Sheehy's **Donrebars All Sorts Of Chaos For Afanbull**.

Limit Bitch

1. Catilina's **Carramba Quentinhill**. White bitch with brindle head markings. Well filled wide head with a good finish, I'd like just a little more profile. Substantial bitch with good bone and a big front, ribs are sprung and has a big powerful

rear end that's well angulated and moved her with drive. A little loose underneath. Shown well.

2. Malden's **Louka Frosty Lady**.

White bitch with correct ear placement, I would like a little more profile, has enough width of head. Good mouth with white teeth, good front, enough bone for size with good feet, although a little red and off colour, well angulated rear end that moved her very well, best mover of the day.

3. Waycott's **Ukusa Rhapsody For Waybully**.

Open Bitch

1. Hicks' **Khlolander Chic Shanique At Crisalia**.

Reserve Best Bitch

Very nice white bitch, beautiful head with profile width and fill, very good ear placement with keen eye, good front and shoulders, carrying the correct weight as to see her spring of rib. Bone is very good as are feet, very good rear end that moved her well, in excellent condition and shown to perfection. Sadly her mouth is not correct but still a quality bitch.

2. Westwood's **Tulsadom's Square Peg**.

Upstanding quality white bitch with a tri eye patch, long sweeping profile that's well filled, very good eye, well placed ears when used, perfect mouth, good lay of shoulder into correct front, good bone and feet, moved well both ways.

3. Sheehy's **Wellinghall Ebony Nugget For Afanbull**.
