### Veteran Dog or Bitch (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Brailsford's **Benjip Black Magic**.  
Black brindle bitch in good coat. A little overweight but at 8 years deserving of an extra treat. Moves OK.

### Puppy Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. McCulloch's **Alizarin Silver Gunsmith**.  
Brindle and white of good make and shape with a nice turn of stifle. Head OK, unfortunately not carrying enough weight.

### Junior Dog (4 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Rae's **Irazistabull Star Of Hades**.  
**Best Dog & Best Opposite Sex**  
Big upstanding black brindle in super condition. His head is packed right up with great depth, slight mouth fault. Short backed, rear end could be stronger for me. Moved OK with drive.  
2. Leggatt & Pilkington's **Javarke Karbon Kopy**.  
Strong big boned black brindle. Powerful head with depth and fill. Unfortunately has instanding canines. I would like a little more length of leg but moved well with drive.  
3. Griffiths' **Varigated Man**.

1. Mortlock's **Sunny's Enter Sandman**.  
Brindle and white in good condition at one with handler. Moved well coming and going.

### Limit Dog (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Seward's **Padhen The Puzzler**.  
**Reserve Best Dog**  
Brindle and white with good bone and loads of substance. Good make and shape, powerful head, moved with drive.

### Open Dog (6 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Kettleborough's **Bullysoul To Hard To Handle**.  
Very mature brindle and white, well constructed male with good spring of rib, moved with drive.  
2. Ley & Bloomfield's **Fortifers Filis Fortune**.  
Sorry recorder failed so no critique.  
3. Dyson's **Gorbain Hellraiser At Tawbarr**.

### Puppy Bitch (3 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Blair's **Louievon Squeezebox Into Megaville**.  
**Best Puppy**  
Brindle and white puppy, small compact bitch. Ear placement rather close, took time to settle on the move but this will improve with practice.  
2. Martin & Hirst's **Dajusa Tel Aviv With Santini**.  
Red and white finely made bitch, would like more bone, she also carries an incorrect bite.

### Junior Bitch (5 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Newberry's **Bullytrip Hells Angel At Ukusa**.  
**Best Bitch & Best In Show**  
Black brindle and white of good make and shape, head turned and filled with correct mouth. Straight front and carried her topline. Moved true coming and going, showed well.  
2. Ramshaw's **Dark Magic Touch**.  
Big upstanding black brindle bitch with lots of virtues. Power packed head with fill and turn. Good Mouth. Good turn of stifle. Lost out to first bitch on movement.  
3. Hackett's **Spartiate Pandora**.

### Maiden Bitch (4 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Lees' **Milly Was My Darling**.  
Sorry recorder malfunctioned again.  
2. Williams' **Cwmdulais Hentarw Black Dahila**.  
Tricolour with decent construction, head turned and filled. Would like more bone. Movement a bit erratic today.

### Novice Bitch (3 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Tittensor's **Jessajack Sweet Sensation**.  
2. Rene's **Lady Noir**.  
Apologies again for recorder.

### Post Graduate Bitch (0 Entries)

### Limit Bitch (6 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Seward's **Padhen Pearls Princess**.  
**Reserve Best Bitch**  
Brindle and white good all round bitch, nice head with neat constructed bodylines. Showed and handled well.  
2. Binks' **Bullbrit Scream**.  
Small compact black brindle with loads of substance. Would like more length to muzzle, moved OK.  
3. Howes & Sheppard's **Ragnarok Daralis With Polanca**.

### Open Bitch (3 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Marples' **Japulca Secret Charm At Taylajay**.  
Brindle and white of nice make and shape. In good condition, moved OK.  
2. Favill's **Padhen Pandoras Box At Krawen**.  
Nice compact brindle bitch who showed well and moved OK.

## The Romany Trophy Competition

We would like to thank the committee for inviting us to judge the Romany Trophy. It's always an honour and a pleasure to judge our beloved breed.

After careful consideration I chose Mr & Mrs Newberry's **Bullytrip Hells Angel By Ukusa**.

A classical black brindle and white bitch, beautiful head with lovely sweeping downface, well placed ears, lovely reach of neck onto well laid shoulders, good tailset, nice tight paws and moved very well, her coat was gleaming and she showed herself like a showgirl. Pleased to award her the Romany Trophy, well deserved.

My choice for runner up was Drs O & L Galla's **Vetsbullies Happiness**.

A lovely compact red and white bitch with a well filled head, good ear placement, short backed well moving girl, she was in excellent condition. With a hard clear coat, showed well.

The dogs were much closer and after some consideration I chose Mr & Mrs Leggatt's **Javarke Karbon Kopy** For Best Opposite Sex.

A typy, black brindle and white dog full of power and substance, a strong filled head, short backed with a good spring of rib, heavy bone and neat paws. Moved better in front than behind.

All exhibits shown were of pleasing quality making my task that bit harder. I fully agreed with my co-judge that the winning competitor would be Mr & Mrs Newberry's **Bullytrip Hells Angel By Ukusa**.

A super black brindle and white bitch with a lovely sweeping filled head, small dark eye, neat ears, nice archy neck, short in back, straight front, tight feet, good angulated quarters, moved well going and coming, in lovely condition and well-handled and shown.

For runner-up I went for Drs O & L Galla's **Vetsbullies Happiness**.

A quality red and white bitch in hard fit condition with a lovely red coat she has a good head and ears, small dark eye, reachy neck, short back, straight front, good bone, decent quarters and moved really well with drive, but not quite the head and dentine of the winner. As agreed with my co-judge.

The dogs were a lot closer, and after some deliberation I went for Mr & Mrs Leggatt's **Javarke Karbon Kopy**.

A cobby typed black brindle and white boy, he is full of power and substance, strong filled and curved head, small dark eye, neat ears, strong reachy neck, good front, heavy bone, short in back, well angled rear end, movement better coming than going, well-shown and well-handled. And a big thank you to all the other competitors for putting up a good show.
