Best Puppy: **Tougher Than The Rest**

A quality entry, apart from the Minor Puppy Dog all exhibits had the temperament we all enjoy from this most delightful breed. One had an ingrowing canine and a small amount had minor mouth faults. Movement was much improved as is heads and shoulders, handling was also much better.

Minor Puppy Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Moore's **Tougher Than The Rest. Best Puppy**

Fawn and white of 9 months, pity he wouldn't let me handle him, handler said he had a scare. I am sure this can be solved and hope it is as he is quite a nice puppy. Super sweep to head, large perfect bite, well off for bone, at the long lean and leggy time.

Puppy Dog (0 Entries)

Junior Dog (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Rae's **Irazistabull Star Of Hades. Reserve Dog CC**

Black brindle and white, in fantastic coat and condition, excellent make and shape with the wow factor. Slight mouth fault in an almost perfect egg shaped head, filled and turned, deep strong under jaw, correct eye shape and well placed ears. Muscular clean neck, strong but clean in shoulders, elbows in, well off for bone, deep chest, well angulated in hindquarters, short firm hocks, correct topline held on the move, moved round the large ring with reach in front and drive behind. I loved him and hope he gets his crown next year when he should be at his best.

Yearling Dog (0 Entries)

Post Graduate Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Newberry's **Ukusa Quagmire**. Obvious who is great sire is, he has stamped his mark. Excellent white, unlucky today. Excellent make and shape, deep in body, short firm in hocks and strong pasterns, correct feet. Tail set on a little high. Perfect large teeth, muscular all over, in very good condition, super

temperament, very well handled, strong deep head with gentle curve, moved well.

Limit Dog (4 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Williams & Hawksford's **Busell's Red Knight Rising**.

Red smut, lovely sweep to head, deep and broad, huge perfect bite, strong neck leading into good shoulders, quality bone and well padded feet. Held strong topline on the move, very good condition and well handled. Useful boy for breeding as he is sound. Loved his expression, dark eye.

Open Dog (5 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Phillips' **Bullyon Unmeasureabull**.

Dog CC & Best Of Breed

When he walked into the ring as my RCC boy did, I felt excited to get my hands on him and I was not disappointed. He has got it all for me and felt that he will mature even a little more later. Big white, powerful boy in fantastic condition, head to die for, clean sweep with that slight down tip at the end. Good pigmentation, perfect bite, deep set triangular eye that looks through you. Ears a little soft. Strong neck, perfect shoulders, held topline on the move, powerful strong pounding movement. Fantastic temperament, excellent condition and will easily win his CCs. One to watch, loved him.

2. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Bertie's Brother**.

Unlucky today. Excellent boy, moved well with that jaunty air, correct head, ears and bite, well placed tail held on the move, in fine condition. Shall also look out for him.

3. Griffiths' **Jessajack Blazin' Inferno**.

Junior Bitch (7 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Hackett's **Spartiate Pandora**. Black brindle and white bitch showing that desired head shape, long, strong and deep, completely filled and turned. Considered her for RCC but she didn't move out as well as I would have liked. Short firm deep body, good spring of rib, quality bone and feet, moved well, in excellent condition.

2. Young's **Bullyview Sweet Memories**.

Promising white, head marks, lovely head, eye and well placed ears, well sprung rib, moved better in front than behind. Excellent handling, happy showgirl.

3. Rustage's **Golitha Jadejones**.

Yearling Bitch (4 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Ball's **Emred Hells Angel At Firecommand**.

White with head marks, excellent condition, good head, deep set eye, ears well placed, super temperament and very well handled. Well balanced height to length, moved parallel, strong firm hocks, well developed second thigh. Sound bitch who will go on to produce as she has much to offer the breed for type and temperament.

Post Graduate Bitch (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Mitchell's **Work Of Art At Beebeemi**.

White, coat could be better presented. Nice head, would like more depth and fill. Perfect bite, well placed and used ears, well balanced height to length of back, tail set on correct. Moved OK round the ring, good temperament.

Limit Bitch (4 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Galla's **Vetsbullies Happiness. Reserve Bitch CC**

Red and white, but notes read wow. In the most fantastic coat and condition. Head could have more finish but it is good enough. Super deep eye, well placed and used ears, strong neck, perfect front and shoulders, correct upper arm, elbows held in. She can lose her topline on the move. Well angulated hindquarters, firm second thigh, excellent padded feet, moved round the ring with ease and parallel with thrust. Must get her crown.

Open Bitch (6 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Blair's **C'est La Vie Into Megaville. Bitch CC**

Couldn't believe my eyes, the very, very best she has ever looked and she knew it. Excellent showgirl, came into the ring with that 'look at me' attitude. I love her make and shape, deep strong. Yes she could be better in front but she cannot be overlooked. Her head as her sire is almost perfect. Large teeth, deep under jaw but still feminine, firm body. Needs more upper arm to be critical but she still moves so well round the ring. Deep thrusting jaunty attitude we all wish for. Congratulations to her breeders, owners and handlers, hard work paid off.

2. Grieves' **Teirwgwyn Miss Independent Of Meilow**.

Excellent make and shape, not moving behind as I am sure she can as she is so well balanced with good second thigh and well angulated quarters. Firm hocks, super head, filled, turned, correct eye and ears, elbows well in, firm topline. Unlucky today but one to watch.
