I wish to thank the committee for the judging invitation and a big thank you to all the exhibitors and their dogs, a lot of quality dogs and excellent temperament. Good to see that mouths in general were very good with only a few mouth faults.

Veteran Dog (5 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Brown's **Ply For Hire.**

8 year old brindle and white male in great condition and enjoying his day, long head with nice profile and small dark eye, straight front, moved OK.

2. Brailsford's **Benjip Black Magic At Kearby.**

7 year old black brindle and white bitch in great condition, good head with gentle profile and wide muzzle, topline dipped on the move.

Puppy Dog (3 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Phillips' **Bullyon Unmeasureabull. Best Puppy**

Just short of his first birthday and with no doubt a promising future, long and well filled head with small dark eyes, nice long neck, short back, straight front, tidy feet, good bone, hard to assess movement as he is a lively boy. Will watch his progress with interest.

2. Foster's **Bilboen Your Eyes Only.**

11 month old white, different type to 1, powerful head with good depth, fill and finish with a keen expression, strong neck, short back, front could be better, moved well when settled.

3. Westwood's **Tulsadoom Mr Grimsdale.**

Junior Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Newberry's **Ukusa Quagmire.**

Best Dog & Best In Show

White with tri head markings, there's nothing not to like about this dog, a lovely well balanced dog with great bone and substance, lovely long and filled head with a keen expression, straight front, short backed, strong quarters, tidy feet, moved very well, one to watch.

Novice Dog (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Burrige & Parks' **Chardaice Dillinger.**

Red and white in excellent condition, strong head with good length, front good, feet tidy, strong bone, moved OK.

2. Moore's **Charming King.**

Lovely brindle colour, could do with a bit more weight, nice head and keen eye but sadly wouldn't use his ears so

spoiled the overall expression, straight front, nice feet, moved OK.

Post Graduate Dog (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Martin & Hirst's **Bullyview Moment Of Madness At Santini.**

White upstanding male, strong head with good length but a little too much brow, straight front and good spring of rib, moves well.

2. Hammill's **The Priest.**

White with eye patch, strong head, wide powerful chest, plenty of bone but carrying a bit too much weight which makes him stuffy in the neck, could do with more angulations to his quarters.

Limit Dog (3 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Kettleborough's **Bullysoul Too Hot To Handle.**

Rich brindle, long and strong head with good fill and profile, when he used his ears they were on top, long neck, strong front, good spring of ribs, strong quarters, moved OK.

2. Morgans' **Marshelsea Trouble Coming At Romagna.**

White with head markings, a lot of size and substance, good profile, nice ear set and good expression, loses his topline on the move.

Open Dog (4 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Twyman & Gardner's **Laronbelle Magic Vision.**

White upstanding male, plenty of bone, good length of head but lacking fill, straight front, coat out of condition, moved very well.

2. White's **Stockleyview Fantastica.**

Nicely marked brindle, well filled and turned head, small eye, ears well placed, straight front, good bone, moved well.

Special Brood Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Martin & Hirst's **Yungwood Sweet Enchantment At Santini.**

Dark brindle and white, good head with good fill and strong underjaw, good expression, correct ear set, straight front, good bend of stifle, moved well.

Puppy Bitch (4 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Phillips' **Bullyon Immeasureabull Ness.**

11 month old white, very feminine, lovely head with good fill, straight front, tight feet, short back, shapely rear quarters, moved well, very promising.

2. Creaghan's **Archagen Weapon Of Choice.**

8 month old white with eye markings, small compact bitch with plenty of bone, feminine head, straight front, shapely neck, moved with drive.

3. Jastrzebska's **Unique Una Timar.**

Junior Bitch (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Binks' **Darling Treasure.**

Very promising well made feminine white with brindle ears, small eye, long neck, lovely front, tidy feet, nice body lines, moved well, to be critical she doesn't use her ears enough, pushed hard for Best Bitch.

Novice Bitch (6 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Brown's **Louka Pretty Lady.**

Tri-coloured terrier type in great condition, long head with good profile, good bone, straight front, straight topline that was held on the move, moved very well.

2. Mills' **Simbarhill Tell Tail Lass.**

Nice brindle, long head but lacking fill, long neck and good shoulders, tidy feet, could do with a bit more bone, moved adequately.

3. Hallahan's **Bullygolytly Bessie Bubble.**

Post Graduate Bitch (3 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Binks' **Superlative Damsel.**

White well quality bitch sadly let down due to a mouth fault, nice feminine head with good length and fill, nice expression, short back, strong rear quarters, moved well.

2. Hammill's **Tiapan Starlight Express.**

White with head markings, nice head and profile, lacks underjaw, good front, slightly long in the back, moved very well.

Limit Bitch (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Favill's **Padhen Pandora's Box At Krawen.**

Brindle and white, well made bitch, nice head with adequate fill, straight front and tidy feet, slightly long cast, moved OK.

Open Bitch (3 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Brown's **Tulsadoom Terry's All Gold.**

Best Bitch & Best Opposite Sex

White, well made bitch with plenty of bone and substance, attractive head with a wicked expression, nice straight front and tidy feet, good shoulder placement, nice bend to stifles, quiet girl who sometimes looks as if she lacks interest, showed well.

2. Howes, Sheppard & Taylor's **Ragnarok Daralis With Polanca.**

Dark brindle, sweeping head with good fill, strong underjaw, very nice front with good bone, long sweeping neck, good shoulders, back could be shorter, moved well and handled well.

3. Favill's **Padhen Pandora's Box At Krawen.**
