With all Clubs suffering from decreasing entries, adding Mini classes makes perfect sense and I was really pleased to be able to go over some quality animals in good numbers. It was encouraging to see a quite a few new handlers and with that, as you would expect some work in progress but a good effort by them all and hopefully with the right encouragement they will continue to make good progress.

Special Beginners Dog Absent

Puppy Dog

1. Read's **Deanny's Bad Boy**. Good sized 10 months red and white, strong powerful head with turn and width to it. One tooth missing. Nice front with good feet, good make and shape. Being new to the ring, a little uneasy at times which showed in his movement, but overall a well balanced young dog.
2. Bunce's **Rubbise It's Complicated**. Very smart black brindle, 7 months, well made young dog, nicely put together, good head. Not quite as short and a little lighter throughout than 1. Moved OK both ways.
3. Farron's **Unionbul's Dark Knight Rises**.

Junior Dog

1. Hilling's **Chardaice Fist Of Fury**. Reserve Best Dog
Good to see brindles making a reappearance in the ring and particularly one as nice as this. In lovely condition, well marked, quality headed dog. A couple of misplaced teeth. Straight front, good shoulders, good feet, the right amount of bone for his size, moved really well, sound young dog with good make and shape holding his topline on the move, shown and presented well.
2. Karta-Williams' **Karmara's Public Enemy**.
Substantially made white with a small eye patch, powerful head which just lacks enough turn and fill, he wasn't keen to let his handler look into his mouth. Decent constructed body with an abundance of bone for his size. He unfortunately gave his handler a difficult time.

Novice Dog

1. Foster's **Bilboen Xtrovert**.
Compact white dog with sweeping turned head. Mouth incorrect. Short compact and well made body with good spring of rib and tidy feet and decent hindquarters, moved OK both ways, nicely presented.
2. Moore's **Charming King**.
Brindle and white, different in type to 1, pleasing head with good mouth, good construction. Slightly long in back. Good bone, nice feet, in good condition. Not quite the compactness and type of 1.

Post Graduate Dog

1. Keenor's **Bobuddy Fuego's Fusilier**.
Substantial well marked brindle and

white, good powerful head, correct mouth, straight front. Feet a little untidy. Well angulated hindquarters. Body a little loose throughout. Good bone, moved OK in front and closer behind. A little unenthusiastic in the ring.

2. Kirk's **Kerbullys Rising Son**.
Smart tri, well made body with a good head. Slightly upright in shoulder, front feet could be tighter. Compact short strong body, moved OK. Preferred the overall quality of 1.
3. Kirk's **Rubbise Angels And Demons**.

Limit Dog

1. Newberry's **Ukusa Ricochet**.
Impressive black brindle, well filled turned head with a good expression, good mouth, muscular neck into straight front, powerful body, tight feet, well developed muscular hindquarters with good bend of stifle, moved well in front and behind. Ideally would have liked to see him shorter in back. A quality dog whose handler worked hard to keep him attentive, presented and shown well.
2. Kirk's **Badlesmere Back Home Again**.
Different in type to 1, much smaller corky white with a good turned head with one slightly soft ear. Short shapely body. Just slightly out at the elbows. Nice feet, good coat, moved OK. Just preferred overall quality and shape of 1.

Open Dog

1. Foster's **Bilboen Velocity**.
Best Dog & Best In Show
Impressive big white with two brindle ears, absolutely power packed head, with strength deep and width to it, good ears and keen expression. One in standing canine. Lots of bone and substance, short back, good spring of rib, a masculine well made dog with lots of quality about him. A little reluctant to show at times and lazy on the move but when he did, he showed he was capable. He could have benefitted from shedding a few extra pounds which would have improved his overall outline and perhaps enthusiasm.
2. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Bertie's Brother**.
Attractive black brindle, good strong head and eye and ear placement, good front, decent feet and strong muscular body, level topline, decent bend of stifle, muscled hindquarters. Moved OK in front and slightly closer behind. Well marked brindle in good condition and handled well. Not quite the overall power and masculinity of 1.
3. Gardner & Twyman's **Laronbelle's Magic Visions**.

Special Beginners Bitch

1. Keenor's **Bobuddy Tears Of Rage**.
Best Puppy
Very smart 11 months feminine white with a head mark, lovely sweeping head. One misplaced tooth. Keen eye with a good expression, good front and shoulders. Still a little immature in body due to her age. Good bend of stifle and strong hindquarters, moved reasonably well, shown and presented nicely.

Puppy Bitch

1. Stratton's **Unionbul's Fallen Angel**.
11 months white, quite well made throughout with good well made hindquarters. Pleasing head but needs more strength, fill and turn. Very attentive to her handler which was good to see for a newcomer and she moved well for a youngster, in good condition.

2. Sheppard's **Red Bossy Boots**.
Very attractive 7 months well marked r/w, gleaming coat, very immature and just needs time to settle and develop. Good head, adequate bone and substance for her age, good make and shape. Just slightly uneasy as I believe this was a first time in the ring but a really good effort.

Junior Bitch

1. Newberry's **Bullytrip Hells Angel At Ukusa**.
Reserve Best Bitch
Super smart black brindle, good head turned and finished with a correct mouth, neat ears, straight front, lovely compact feminine body, tidy feet and good bend of stifle, moved well, in lovely condition and handled well, a nicely balanced bitch throughout.
2. Creaghan's **Archangen Weapon Of Choice**.
White with black eye/ear mark, strong well filled head with correct mouth, good reach of neck. Slightly longer in back than 1, one foot a little loose. Good bone and substance, nice quality bitch, moved well.
3. Karta-Williams' **Karmara's Rumour Has It**.

Novice Bitch

1. Morgans' **Romagna Rumour Has It**.
Quality headed good sized bitch. Slight mouth fault, ears a little soft. Well put together throughout with good bone, nice feet, straight front, well place shoulders, good length of back and hindquarters, moved reasonably well in front and behind.
2. Chapman's **Ladyfire Red Alert**.
Well made bitch with decent head not as strong as 1. Correct mouth. Shapely body just a little loose all-round. Tight feet with adequate bone and decent movement.
3. Sheppard's **Bullnose Living It Large**.

Post Graduate Bitch

1. Karta-Williams' **Karmara Consider Me**.
Best Bitch & Best Opposite Sex
Big upstanding eye-catching white bitch, in outline she looks a picture with a sweeping profile, keen expression, well place ears, lovely reach of neck and good front leading into feminine shapely body with good hindquarters. She unfortunately is mismarked at the base of her tail but she is an elegant, balanced bitch.
2. Klammer's **Dollys Sweet Desire**.
Pleasing head, not the strength and profile of 1. Well balanced, good substance, neat feet, moved reasonably well. Her young handler really got the best out of her.
3. Mitchell's **Work Of Art At Beebeemi**.
