I would like to thank the committee for the opportunity to judge this excellent Show and the stewards for all their help. I would also like to thank the exhibitors for the wonderful entry. Some of the classes were very strong both in numbers and quality, therefore there were many close decisions and some first class animals remained unplaced. This was without doubt my most challenging judging assignment to date.

Puppy Dog (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Price's **Keznel Rock n' Rolla**. Large powerful 11 month old white. Strong head with profile and fill. Good eye and ear placement. Straight front, good, bone tight feet. Moved well both ways, unfortunately he was a little unsure of himself.

Maiden Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Broadhurst's **Rightstuff Rebel A Bull**. Terrier type white. Excellent head with profile and fill. Small triangular eyes and well placed ears giving a great expression. Mouth undershot, short back, good topline but I would like to see more bone and weight. Unruly on the move.

Novice Dog (0 Entries)

Junior Dog (3 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Howes & Sheppard's **Polanca Powerslave**. Medium sized brindle and white. Long deep head with an unbroken profile, enough width and fill and correct mouth. Good reach of neck, correct shoulder and good topline. Straight front with tight feet just turns one foot out a little, moved with drive.

2. Leggatt's **Rabram Royal Star**. Substantial black brindle and white. Long powerful head with a gentle profile, good width and fill and one misplaced canine. Straight front, good feet, powerful quarters and moved well, just a little long in back.

3. Hammill's **Davelainy's Son Of A Preacher**.

Post Graduate Dog (5 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Westwood's **Broken Arrows Peaky Blinder At Tulsadom**.

Quality brindle and white. Deep head with a good profile, well filled under the eye and enough width of muzzle, mouth level. Powerful neck leading to well placed shoulders, straight front, powerful quarters, moved well in front a little close behind.

2. Bunce's **Rubbise It's Complicated**. Heavyweight black brindle and white. Deep wide head with good fill, slight eyebrow breaking a good profile. Nice expression, mouth incorrect. Good round bone and a straight front. Moved closed behind.

3. Wannop's **Off The Charts At Charishalee**.

Limit Dog (10 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Rae's **Irazistabull Star Of Hades**. Tall elegant black brindle and white. Excellent head with a sweeping profile enough width and fill. Very good eye and expression, slight mouth fault, ramrod straight front and beautiful cat feet. Long elegant neck, short deep body, rear movement lacked drive.

2. Evans' **Bronygarn Bold As Brass**. Medium sized black brindle and white. Powerful deep head with good width, profile and a good mouth. Long powerful neck leading to well placed shoulders, straight front and good feet, short powerful body, nice bend of stifle, moved a little close behind.

3. Dobbin's **Debully In For The Kill**.

4. Smalley's **Briden Backchat**.

Open Dog (10 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Lamony's **Ch. Emred Devil's Advocate**.

Dog CC
Short, cobby red and white. Excellent power packed head, good fill, width and roman finish. Mouth OK, good eye and expression, thick neck, good shoulder, very short deep body, lovely round bone, straight front and good feet. Moved OK in front close behind.

2. Young's **Ch. Feenicks Next Generation At Bullyview**.

Reserve Dog CC
First class heavyweight red. Powerful well filled head with an unbroken profile, mouth correct, good ear placement, eye a little large giving a kinder expression than the first. Good shoulder placement, nice round bone, straight front, short deep body, powerful quarters, moved well. A very close decision between one and two in a class filled with quality dogs.

3. Woodward's **Ch. Gorbain Hellboy**.

4. Mathison's **Ch. Blazinbullys Dark Knight**.

Puppy Bitch (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Godsall's **Ukusa Jezabel To Neverland**.

Best Puppy
Tall brindle and white, long deep head with a pleasing profile, enough fill and a good mouth. Nice reach of neck, straight front and good quarters, moved with drive, just a shade long in the back.

2. Kettleborough's **Bullysoul Janice**. Terrier type white, attractive feminine head with a gentle profile, could do with a little more fill. Good mouth, eye, front and feet, moved a little closed behind.

Maiden Bitch (0 Entries)

Novice Bitch (5 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. Carrick's **Bullbrand Broken Promise**. Tall tricolour with an attractive well filled head, good profile, mouth and eye, straight front, tight feet, well muscled quarters, moved well in front a shade close behind.

2. Hodges' **Bronygarn Autumnal Gold At Shwntarv**. Heavyweight fawn. Super head with excellent profile, width and depth, correct mouth, good bone, lost topline on the move.

Junior Bitch (5 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Foster & Bicker's **Bilboen Beyond The Stars**.

Bitch CC & Best In Show
Upstanding black brindle and white with a long deep well fill head, sweeping profile, good mouth and expression. Long well arched neck and straight front, good round

bone, nice bend of stifle, moved with drive. In the challenge I preferred her overall power and substance.

2. O'Connell's **Koellen Penny Black**. Attractive feminine black brindle. Super head with excellent profile, well filled under her small dark eyes, good mouth, straight front, nice cat feet, very short back, moved with drive.

3. Woodward's **Gorbain Diamond Diva**.

4. Dyson's **Gorbain Ice Maiden Tawnbarr**.

Post Graduate Bitch (10 Entries, 5 Absent)

1. Kocaba & White's **Bilboen Angels Kiss**. Attractive medium sized brindle and white. Long head with a sweeping profile and good fill. Mouth has one misplaced canine. Nice reach of neck leading to good shoulder and short back. Straight front, tight feet, moved a little close behind.

2. Taylor's **Koellen Tri Being A Girl At Zankol**. Heavyweight tricolour with a short deep head, super profile, good fill and width. Mouth incorrect. Straight front, a little upright in shoulder, moved close behind.

3. Moore's **My Book Of Dreams**.

4. Stratton's **Unionbul's Fallen Angel**.

Limit Bitch (13 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Dobbin's **Debully Vagabond Queen**.

Reserve Bitch CC
Tall elegant white. Lovely head with a sweeping profile, good fill under the eyes, correct mouth, small triangular eyes giving a good expression. Long arched neck, straight front, good feet and well bent stifles. Moved well in front a little close behind. Just shaded in the challenge by the extra power of the CC winner.

2. McCann's **Ukusa Vegas At Diton**. Medium sized white. Attractive head with a good profile, well filled under the eyes and with enough width. Correct mouth, eye and ear placement giving an excellent expression. Straight front, good round bone, nice feet, short deep body, well developed quarters, moved with drive, just a little close behind.

3. Howes & Sheppard's **Ragnarok Daralis With Polanca**.

4. Thomas' **Bronygarn Bobby's Girl At Mostahbull**.

Open Bitch (15 Entries, 6 Absent)

1. Newberry's **Bullytrip Hell's Angel By Ukusa**. Attractive feminine tricolour. Her head has an excellent profile with good fill under the eyes and a good mouth. Small dark eyes giving a good expression. Excellent reach of neck leading to good shoulders, correct length of back, a lovely straight front and well bent stifles. Her beautiful flowing body lines just edged this class packed with first class animals, but in the challenge she lost out to the greater power of the CC & RCC winners.

2. Ramshaw's **Dark Magic Touch**. Substantial black brindle and white with a powerful well filled head. Good profile and mouth. Strong deep neck, straight front, excellent bone, tight feet and well developed quarters. Just a shade longer in back than the first but a top quality bitch.

3. Phillips' **Ch. Bullyon Imeasureabull Ness**.

4. L'Homme's **Goodbye To Helen Wheels At Kaiserbull**.
