I was very happy with the overall quality and conformation to breed type and last but not least my sincere thanks to the exhibitors who travelled to show their dogs under me - thank you so much.

Special Beginners Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Howes & Sheppard's **Polanca Powerslave**.

9 month old nicely marked brindle and white, sweeping profile, good fill and ears well set, lots of bone, good front and tidy feet, level top line and moved well both ways for one so young.

Puppy Dog (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Bunce's **Rubbise Its Complicated**.

Best Puppy

Very well made black brindle and white, strong head with lots of fill, good profile and all filled up, straight front, lots of fore chest and spring of rib, good shoulder placement into well laid shoulder and top line, nice rear end and, moved well in front but a little close in front.

2. Gemmel & Tyrman's **Ukusa Vanguard**.

All white, a more cobby type dog, nice profile with lots of fill under the eye, strong neck, level top line, good bone and good rear quarters, moved well both ways.

Junior Dog (2 Entries, 2 Absent)

Novice Dog (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Smith's **Romagna Mystic Ice**.

All white, a more middle of road type with good profile, lots of roman finish with bags of fill, lots of bone and nice feet. Good forechest and spring of rib, strong rear quarters, well developed second thigh and moved wide with drive both ways.

Post Graduate Dog (5 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Newberry's **Ukusa Ricochet**.

A large upstanding well made brindle and white, he's a big bull type dog with lots of substance, with a strong profile and roman finish heads all filled up and ears bang on top and a nice eye, a straight front and beautiful feet, gun barrel chest, well placed shoulder

and level top line and very strong rear with angulation. Moved well for such a big boy, pushed all the way for Best Coloured.

2. Smalley's **Briden Backchat**.

White, he is a more cobby dog than the class winner, nice egg shape head with lots of turn, ears well placed, wicked eye, good top line, tail well set, good rear angulation and moved well both ways with drive.

3. Hilling's **Chardaice Fist Of Fury**.

4. Kirk's **Kerbullys Rising Son**.

5. Young' **Kilacabar Rock And Rolla**.

Limit Dog (5 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Gardner & Twyman's **Laronbelles Magic Visions**.

White with head mark, he is a big boy with lots of bone and substance with a sweeping profile, ears bang on top used them all the time, good fill and roman finish with a wicked eye, long strong neck, straight front. Neat feet, lots of spring of rib, long neck into good shoulder, strong quarters and tail well set and moved well both ways with drive and held his top line on the move.

2. Pickering's **Ukusa Kaos De Peracho**.

White with head marks, nice egg shape head, wicked eye, I'd prefer a little more width in muzzle perhaps, good level top line and rear angulations and moved well in front but shade close behind.

3. Kirk's **Rubbise Angels And Demons**.

4. Parkes & Burridge's **Chardaice Dillinger**.

5. Kirk's **Badlesmere Back Home Again**.

Open Dog (5 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Blair's **Megaville's Signing Off**.

Dog CC & Best In Show

White with head marks caught my eye as soon as he walked into the ring. He has a well chiselled outline, screams quality all over and his head's all packed up with a sweeping profile, ears bang on top and used them all the time and roman finish with a wicked eye, long strong neck, straight front and beautiful feet, lots of spring of rib, good shoulder placement and a powerful rear end and correct tail set, moved well both in front and behind with drive and purpose, well handled and presented. I was very happy to award the Challenge Certificate to him.

2. Roff's **Bobuddy Trafalgar**.

Reserve Dog CC

White with head marking, he is a large bull type male, strong head and good profile all filled up under the eye and nice roman finish, good width of muzzle, lots of bone, nice straight front and cat like feet. Strong neck and level top line, loads of forechest with spring of rib, strong back end and moved well both ways, pressed hard for the Challenge Certificate.

3. Newberry's **Ukusa Quagmire**.

4. Mathison's **Notorious Joker Of Blazinbulls**.

5. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Bertie's Brother**.

Special Beginners Bitch (3 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Taylor's **Ragnarok Eostre**.

Well marked red and white, nice profile and roman finish, ears well set, long neck into good shoulder and level top line, nice front and rear angulation and moved well for being still a baby.

2. Gannon & Dawson's **Greenlove Queen Of Hearts**.

Nicely marked black brindle and white, very similar type to the class winner. Nice feminine expression with gentle profile, used her ears all the time, again a nice front and forechest, level top line and moved well in front but a little close in rear.

3. Malden's **Louka Frosty Lady SHCM**.

Puppy Bitch (7 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Creaghan's **Archagen Freak Unique**.

White with head mark, a more of a middle road bitch, strong but feminine head lots of turn and fill, ears well set, nice eye, long reach of neck, good shoulder and top line, straight front, tidy feet. Good depth of brisket and spring of rib, good rear quarters and moved well both ways.

2. Carrick's **Bullbrand Banshee**.

Well marked tri-colour, nice elegant bitch, beautiful head nice sweeping profile, ears bang on top, nice eye for coloured, nice roman finish, straight front, cat like feet, nice reach of neck and level top line, tail well set and moved OK both ways.

3. O'Connell's **Koellen Penny Black**.

4. Taylor's **Polanca Come As You Are To Ragnarok**.

5. Gannon & Dawson's **Greenlove Queen Of Hearts**.

Junior Bitch (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Stratton's **Unionbulls Fallen Angel**.

White, a more terrier type of bitch, good profile would perhaps like a little more fill under the eye, wicked eye, used her ears well, long neck, good front and top line and good rear quarters, moved well in front shade close from behind.

2. Malden's **Louka Special Lady**.

All white with a sweeping profile and roman finish, could do with more width in muzzle and she tends to turn her feet out, lots of spring of rib and strong rear quarters, moved close in front and better going away. Her coat was a bit out of condition.

Novice Bitch (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Thomas' **Bronygarn Bobby's Girl At Mostahbull**.

A very 'Ghabar' type of girl, unbroken profile, wicked eye, lots of forechest substance and bone, gun barrel chest, strong back end, moved well both ways. A very happy girl, enjoyed herself in ring.

Post Graduate Bitch (8 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Morgans & Wilson's **Romagna Drama Queen**.

Brindle and white, a big strong bull type bitch with lots of bone, strong head with sweeping profile, lots of fill under eye and finish, powerful neck into well-laid shoulder, straight front and beautiful feet, lots of depth and spring

of rib, good rear angulations, well developed thigh and moved with drive.

2. Ramshaw's **Dark Magic Touch**.

Large upstanding yet still a very feminine girl, black brindle and white, strong head with lovely profile and wide muzzle, straight front, tidy feet, excellent bone and level top line, well made quarters, moved close behind OK in front.

3. Smalley's **Bridens Summer Breeze**.

4. Karta-Williams' **Karmara Consider Me**.

5. Klammer's **Dolly's Sweet Desire**.

Limit Bitch (7 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Newberry's **Bullytrip Hell's Angel By Ukusa**.

Beautiful marked tri-colour, nice elegant lines, lovely feminine expression, sweeping profile, good eye and fill, ears well set, long neck, nice lay of shoulder and level top line, straight front, cat like feet, good rear angulation and moved well both ways, presented in stunning condition a credit to her owners, and one who I believe has a very bright future.

2. Ball's **Emred Hell's Angel At Firecommand**.

All white with head mark, she is a cobby type with a very egg shaped head, lots of turn in head with strength and fill under her eye, lots of forechest and gun barrel chest, good top line and rear quarters, moved close in front and better from behind. I was happy to give her 2nd in a very good class, well handled by her owner.

3. Mitchell's **Work Of Art At Beebeemi**.

Open Bitch (5 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Gaigher's **Heaven White Himalaya's Snow Mountains**.

Bitch CC

Large upstanding white with head markings yet still a very elegant and feminine girl, fantastic profile good length of muzzle, used her ears all the time, her head's all filled, wicked eye and roman finish, long reach of neck with lots of forechest and depth and spring of rib, straight front and cat like feet, powerful rear end and tail well set, held her top line well and moved both from front and behind with drive, well handled and presented.

2. Young's **Bullyview Sweet Memories**.

Reserve Bitch CC

White with head mark, she is a more cobby type of girl than the class winner, she has a beautiful head with a sweeping profile with lots of fill, powerful yet with an elegant expression, used her ears all of the time, strong neck leading into good shoulder and top line, straight front, cat like feet, powerful rear quarters and moved well both ways, another who was handled and presented in beautiful condition.

3. Blair's **Aricon Eye Society Into Megaville**.
