I was happy to help out the Club at short notice following the accident to Heidi Holland's husband which made it unable for her to fulfil the engagement.

Special Beginners Dog (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Tudor's **Ukusa Fire Demon**.
Upstanding 30 month old red and white shown in gleaming hard condition with heavy bone and neat feet, would benefit from a little better shoulder placement and is a shade straight in stifle, head is well filled with good expression, moved close behind.

Puppy Dog (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Roff's **Bobuddy Bronn**.

Best Puppy, Best Dog & Best Opposite Sex

Heavyweight white, 10 months with immense bone and substance, straight front and tight feet, well turned head with good fill and finish, neat ears all giving rise to terrific expression, untidy pincer bite, reasonable shoulders into short back, deep brisket, well muscled quarters with good short hocks, moved pretty well both ways.

2. Lacey's **Lacey The Legend**.

Black brindle of 9 months, not as mature as 1 and proving a bit of a handful, nicely turned head with keen eye, good ear set and scissor bite, good bone, neat feet, shoulder placement could be a little better and tends to stand high at the rear, hard to assess movement.

Junior Dog (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Smets' **Hoodstar Inglorious Bastard At Little Thunders**.

Stylish upstanding white of 15months, well turned head, good ear set, keen expression, mouth just off, reasonable shoulder, short coupled, deep brisket, good bone and tight feet, well made quarters, moved pretty well both ways.

Novice Dog (3 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Hackett's **Spartiate King Leonidas**.
Heavyweight white, 2 years, terrific bone and substance, short coupled, deep brisket and good breadth across shoulders, strong quarters, tight feet, strong head with broken profile, good ear set and keen expression, mouth just off, moved pretty well both ways.
2. Heard's **Shacadia's Black Mamba At Glazed**.

Solid brindle, rising 3 years, well turned head with good fill and finish, scissor bite, adequate bone and neat feet, would prefer a little more layback in shoulder, short back, moved better going than coming.
3. Samson's **Koellen Cuban Gold**.

Limit Dog (6 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Pullen's **Louka Gone Racin'**.

Reserve Best Dog

Black brindle with gleaming jacket shown and presented in great condition, gentle turned head with good fill, scissor bite, keen eye, ears carried a little wide, straight front with good bone and tight feet. Long strong neck into reasonable shoulder, shade long cast, strong quarters, moved pretty much parallel coming and a little close going.
2. Jerome & Cambridge's **Ounsdale Return Of The Mac At Elysianplain**.

Flashy black brindle, powerful and compact, strong head, scissor bite, short back, reasonable quarters, moved better going than coming and could not hold topline on the move.

Open Dog (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Kocaba's **Badlesmere Bertie's Brother**.

Upstanding 5 years black brindle with a stylish swagger, strong head though lacking a touch in both profile and fill, scissor bite but discoloured teeth, strong bone, tight feet, deep brisket, good shoulder and well made quarters though moved quite close behind.

Veteran Dog or Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Brown's **Ply For Hire**.

You just would not know from the great hard condition and animation of this brindle and white that he was rising 10 years, a great credit to his owner, strong turned head, scissor bite, keen eye, strong bone, short back and well made quarters, though moved close behind.

Special Beginners Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Waycott's **Ukusa Rhapsody For Waybully**.

Quality white with red ears and eye patch, 30 months, strong filled head with gentle turn, keen expression, scissor bite, adequate bone, reasonable shoulder, a shade long cast, moved a little close both ways.

Puppy Bitch (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Smets' **In Love With Little Thunders**.

Upstanding stylish 7 months white with well turned head, good ear set, keen expression, scissor bite though with one tooth out of line, long neck into reasonable shoulder and short back, adequate bone and quarters, moved close behind.
2. Membury's **White Fancy Free At Miztstaff**.

9 month white with strong head, gentle profile, keen expression and scissor bite, good brisket and bone, tight feet, a shade long cast and would benefit from a little better shoulder placement, unsettled on the move and hard to assess.

Junior Bitch (5 Entries, 3 Absent)

1. O'Connell's **Koellen Penny Black**.

Best Bitch & Best In Show

Top quality black brindle just out of puppy, standing square, well

balanced and shown in good hard condition, sweeping down face but could perhaps do with a little more fill under the eyes, good ear set, keen expression, scissor bite but with one inclining canine, long strong neck through well placed shoulder into short back, well muscled quarters, straight front, good bone and neat feet, held topline but moved close behind.

2. Dawson & Gannon's **Greenlove Queen Of Hearts**.

Black brindle, just out of puppy, strong gentle profile to head, keen expression, good ear set, scissor bite, would benefit from a little more layback in shoulder, straight front when standing and tight feet, a shade long cast, well muscled quarters, moved close behind and did not hold topline.

3. Malden's **Rubbise Causing Chaos At Louka**.

Novice Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Brown's **Louka Pretty Lady**.

Powerful tricolour, rising 2 years with gentle profile, good fill, keen expression, pincer bite, good bone, tight feet, deep brisket, a little better shoulder layback and more angulation at the rear would complete the picture, moved a little wide coming and a little close going.

Limit Bitch (8 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Morgans' **Romagna Rumour Has It**.

Reserve Best Bitch

Top quality all white 2 year old, upstanding, well balanced and substantial yet retaining femininity, powerful turned head with good fill and finish, neat well placed ears, keen eye all giving rise to excellent expression, undershot, strong long neck through well placed shoulder, short back, deep brisket, well made quarters, straight front but feet a little untidy, moved close behind.

2. Malden's **Louka Frosty Lady SCHM**.

3 year old all white with gentle profile, good expression and scissor bite, straight front, adequate bone, well made quarters, moved close behind.

3. Waycott's **Ukusa Rhapsody For Waybully**.

4. Kocaba & White's **Shanthana Thai Black Orchid**.

Open Bitch (2 Entries, 2 Absent)

Special Brood Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Jerome's **Hardysview Miss Cerberus For Elysianplain**.

Upstanding white with tricolour eye patch, well turned head with good fill, keen eye, good ear set, straight front, deep brisket, well boned, would benefit from a little more angulation at the rear, moved close behind.
