Puppy Dog (4 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Howes & Sheppard's **Polanca Powerslave**.

Best Puppy & Reserve Best Dog

Well marked substantial brindle.

Lovely filled head with correct

profile. Neat well placed ears, good

eye. Nice reach of neck into well

placed shoulders and good tight

feet. Plenty of bone for a young

boy. Good turn of stifle, moved and

handled well.

2. Catilina & Szewczyk's **Quentinhill Hattori Hanzo**.

White with red ear. Compact dog

with good bone and substance for

age, would like tighter feet, compact

head with width, good expression.

Hard work for handler, moved well.

3. Roff's **Bobuddy Bronn**.

4. Hutchinson's **Bryonteez Casey Ryeback**.

Junior Dog (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Parkington's **Bradak's Ruthless Remedy**.

Well marked red and white. Good

width to head with nice profile,

would like slightly more fill but may

come with maturity. Short backed

with good bone and tight feet.

Needs time to settle when moving.

Maiden Dog (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Parkington's **Bradak's Ruthless Remedy**.

Novice Dog (3 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Hackett's **Spartiate King Leonidas**.

White dog with terrific bone and

substance, deep chest with good

straight bone and tight feet. His

head is strong with good ear

placement and keen expression.

Moves well both ways but loses

topline slightly.

2. Parkington's **Bradak's Ruthless Remedy**.

3. Weldrake's **Dazlin Thunderstruck At Megabull**.

Post Graduate Dog (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Wormald's **Stand And Deliver Sir**.

Nice head with good length and

good eye and ear placement. Long

reach of neck into good front with

enough bone and substance.

Slightly long cast but good turn of

stifle, moved OK although hard to

assess as he was rather lively.

Limit Dog (0 Entries)

Open Dog (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Blair's **Megaville Higher Ground**.

Best Dog & Best Opposite Sex

Compact and substantial white with

black ears. Good strong head with

plenty of depth and fill. Good length

of neck into well placed shoulders

and very good tight feet. Short

backed with good rear angulation

which he uses well when he moves

with drive holding his topline.

2. Lopez' **Cosmopolitan Ordeal By Fire**.

Red and white with a good straight

front completed with good shoulder

placement and reach of neck. Feet

OK, level topline which holds well on

the move. Good ear placement, nice

width and fill to head.

Puppy Bitch (3 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Wilamowska's **Quentinhill Black Diamond**.

Very feminine small bitch, straight

front with nice feet, short deep

head, uses ears well when

concentrating. Short backed, nice

turn of stifle, needs time to settle

when moving.

Junior Bitch (5 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. McCann's **Ukusa Vegas At Diton**.

Best Bitch & Best Of Breed

Beautifully balanced white bitch.

Feminine head with a correct profile

and good eye and ear placement

giving correct expression. Lovely

reach of neck into well placed

shoulders, deep chest and short

back. Good straight front with

enough bone and nice tight feet,

holds topline when moving.

2. Moore's **My Book Of Dreams**.

Substantial red bitch with good

bone, straight front and tight

feet. Deep head with correct ear

placement, short backed and

good rear angulation. Moves well

although rather laid back today.

3. Parkin's **Quentinhill Duchess Of Revlon**.

4. Bloom's **Abenaki Brief**

Encounter.

5. Wormald's **Bradak's Ghetto**

Princess.

Maiden Bitch (5 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Bloom's **Abenaki Romantic**

Destiny.

Nice white bitch with short deep

head with good profile, nice

expression finished with beautiful

ears. Straight front, enough bone

and good feet. Good turn of stifle

and moves well. Look forward to

seeing her mature.

2. Parkin's **Quentinhill Duchess Of Revlon**.

White bitch with red ear. Good

bone and substance. Head has

good length and profile, nice ear

placement and wicked expression.

Nice length of neck but would prefer

better lay of shoulder. Nice length of

back, good rear angulations, moved

well both ways.

3. Willian's **Golitha Jessicaennis**.

4. Stanley's **Credetta Sugar Horse**.

Novice Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Paterson's **Golitha Hocus Pocus**.

White with tri eye patch. Gentle

profile to head with good ears and

eye placement, adequate bone

and substance, feet OK. Nice turn

of stifle, slightly long cast, made

handler work hard, moved OK once

settled.

Post Graduate Bitch (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Moore's **Lil' Lady Fire Cracker**.

Red and white with nice make and

shape. Deep filled head but lacks in

profile but has good ear placement.

Her front is square with good bone

and tight feet. Good shoulder

placement into a short back with

level topline. Good rear angulation

and moves well both ways. Carrying

slightly too much weight today.

2. Hearne & Singleton's **Dajusa This Is Love Warbonnet**.

Red and white bitch, lighter in bone

than 1. Straight front with good

tight feet. Nice length to back with

good turn of stifle. Hard to assess

movement as she wouldn't settle.

Limit Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Littlefair's **Dikram Tribal Magic**.

Lovely tri-colour bitch. Beautiful

profile, deep head with good ear

placement. Very square when stood,

good front, plenty of bone, good

feet. Moves very well with drive both

ways. In excellent condition and

shows very well for her handler.

Open Bitch (4 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Ramshaw's **Dark Magic Touch**.

Reserve Best Bitch

Upstanding black brindle girl, very

good bone and substance. Head

has good length and depth. Good

ear and eye placement. Straight

front with deep chest, good tight

feet. Lovely length of neck into good

shoulders. Short backed, good rear

angulation, moves well both ways

holding her topline.

2. Szewczyk's **Dorotka Rewelacja Z Galicji**.

9 year old bitch that has good bone

and substance, moved very well for

her age and showed herself off well

for her handler.
