BOS & BP: **Rabram Rock Star**

I would firstly like to thank the committee for the appointment for this Show, and then thank the exhibitors and spectators for the support. I had some lovely dogs to judge on the day.

Puppy Dog (4 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Leggatt's **Rabram Rock Star**.

Best Puppy & Best Dog

White with eye patch, very balanced young dog with correct mouth, excellent fill and profile, ears well placed, small dark eye, good reach of neck into well placed shoulders, short back, correct tail set, his movement was good both ways just a tad loose but will come with age, neat tight feet.

2. Westwood's **Tulsadoom**

Kabukimono.

Brindle and white dog, another quality young dog who will improve with age I am sure, lovely width to his head with fill, ears correct and used them well, correct mouth. Length of neck good, upper arm a little short which made him ever so slightly long in back. A powerful youngster who moved well.

3. Caldicott's **Dofro's Ghost Rider**.

4. Gibbs' **Ukusa Anarchist**.

Novice Dog (4 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Wright's **Rightstuff Revelation**.

White with black ears, this dog has a great expression with a tiny dark eye, well arched head, a little narrow in the muzzle, mouth OK, short in back with good forechest, moved well in front, his rear movement lets him down.

2. Moore's **Tilleah Tougher Than The Rest**.

Red and white heavyweight dog, profile good with width to his head, ears well placed, eye a little kind and mouth undershot, moved better behind than in front with a good bend of stifle which gave him the good rear action.

3. Rene's **Bluepoint Wilderness**.

Maiden Dog (0 Entries)

Junior Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Caldicott's **Dofro's Ghost Rider**.

White with black ears, a dog with plenty of bone, wicked expression with gentle profile, nice reach of neck, level topline, movement was better behind on tight feet.

Post Graduate Dog (5 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Lister's **Emred Double Dealer**.

Reserve Best Dog

White with black ear, led his handler a merry dance today, when he stood still he stood well balanced, head has width and fill, mouth good, ears well placed, short in back with elbows tucked in and correct rear angulation, movement hard to asses as he just would not settle.

2. Moore's **Charming King**.

Rich brindle dog, he has width to his head, mouth correct, but is lacking in arc and fill, this said he is a very sound dog with good body lines and is an excellent mover, shoulders well placed with elbows tucked in, topline level and rear angulation correct.

3. Parkington's **Bradak's Ruthless Remedy**.

4. Mills' **Miinroc Only The Brave**.

5. Lightburn's **Bradak Inkredibull General At Funkaidellix**.

Limit Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Hackett's **Spartiate King Leonidas**.

All white real heavyweight dog with masses of bone, he has width to his head with roman finish just lacking fill under the eye, ears a little soft on the move, length of neck good into well placed shoulders, rear angulation OK, movement better in front than behind.

Open Dog (1 Entry, 1 Absent)

Veteran Dog or Bitch (5 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Draper's **Emred Zurie Par Albaeda**.

White with red patch, lovely condition for her age, gentle unbroken profile, ears well placed, small dark eye, length of neck correct, shoulders well placed, her movement was good and she really enjoyed being back in the ring.

2. Morgans' **Marshelsea Trouble Coming At Romagna**.

White dog with black ears, another one enjoying his day in the ring and letting his owner know, still got a keen expression and a lovely head, his movement is loose now, but he has well placed shoulders and topline.

3. Favill's **Padhen Pandoras Box At Krawen**.

Special Brood Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Moore's **Tilleah My Book Of Dreams**.

Red and white bitch, pleasing head with fill but would like more finish, mouth correct, ears well placed, shoulders correct with good forechest, topline dipping a little on the move which was close behind.

Puppy Bitch (7 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Leggatt's **Rabram Rolling Deep**.

Reserve Best Bitch

White with brindle ears, litter sister to BPIS, very typy bitch with small neat ears and dark eye giving keen expression, gentle profile, mouth OK, good reach of neck with well placed shoulders, turned her feet out slightly, short back, movement OK but needs more time to mature.

2. Westwood's **Tulsadoom Forty Elephants**.

All white girl, a lot heavier set than first, with keen expression, mouth OK and ears well set, not as short in back as first placed, shoulders slightly upright, rear angulation OK, moved well both ways on tight feet, another girl that will improve with age.

3. Wright's **Star Venture At Rightstuff**.

Novice Bitch (3 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Kettleborough's **Bullysoul Little Darling**.

All white bitch, very feminine girl with ears bang on top, didn't stop showing in the ring, her head lacks fill and finish but she has a lovely small dark eye and correct mouth, clean bodylines, elbows tucked well in, movement lovely on tight feet.

2. Wright's **Rightstuff I Predict A Riot**.

Brindle and white, very much a baby, she has good width to her head with gentle profile, mouth slightly off, good angulation, she needs time to mature, moves very much like the baby she is.

3. Oldmeadow & Jones' **Unionbul's Catching Fire**.

Maiden Bitch (2 Entries 1 Absent)

1. Parkin's **Quentinhill Duchess Of Revlon**.

White with red ear, pleasing expression, lacks fill under the eye, ears used well, good reach of neck and well placed shoulders with strong straight front, level topline when moving which was true.

Junior Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Din's **Selbullie Is Miss Divine**.

White with brindle ear, feminine youngster, would like a little more profile, kind expression, mouth correct, good length of neck and shoulders, correct rear angulation with straight front, movement OK.

Post Graduate Bitch (7 Entries, 6 Absent)

1. Moore's **Tilleah My Book Of Dreams**.

Limit Bitch (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Godsall's **Ukusa Jezebel To Neverland**.

Best Bitch & Best In Show

Brindle bitch, this girl was showing the moment she entered the ring, a large girl but not overdone in anyway, very pleasing wide head with sweeping profile, ears bang on top and mouth correct, long elegant neck into correct shoulders with a gun barrel front, rear angulation very good which gave her excellent movement, this girl covered the ring with ease.

2. Mills' **Miinroc Envy Me**.

Red and white feminine bitch with good profile, not the width of head as winner, short back and straight front, rear angulation a little straight, movement good on tight feet.

Open Bitch (6 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Brailsford's **Stockleyview Solitaire**.

Brindle and white mature girl with sweeping profile, mouth correct, ears carried well, good length of neck into well placed shoulders, held her topline well on the move which was good.

2. Morgans' **Romagna Rumour Has It**.

White bitch, ears carried bang on top, lacking a little fill but small keen eye, good length of neck, shoulders correct, elbows could be tighter, feet untidy but moved OK.
