I would like to thank the Committee for giving me the opportunity to judge at the North East Bull Terrier Club.

Minor Puppy Dog (0 Entries)

Puppy Dog (1 Entry, 0 Absent)

1. Leggatt's **Rabram Rock Star**.

10 month old white with eye patch, head has good length with plenty of width to muzzle, turned profile and roman finish, good ear placement, used well, keen expression. Nice shoulder placement, with ample bone to front legs, short backed and moves well once settled.

Junior Dog (2 Entries, 0 Absent)

1. Nisbet & Kelly's **Serenbull Buffalo Soldier**.

Red and white dog of 13 months, enough bone for compact size. Short turned head, well filled with good expression, straight front with good round bone and tidy feet but at this age still needs to develop forechest. Level topline and tail carriage, good turn of stifle, moved well.

2. Hara's **Serenbull Roman Vagabond**.

13 month old red and white, litter brother to 1, very similar make and shape to his brother although not quite the power in his head. Nice length of neck into good shoulders, ample bone with good feet, hard to assess movement as he was a very happy boy, should settle with practice.

Novice Dog (6 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Nisbet & Kelly's **Serenbull Soul Redemption**.

13 month tricolour, lovely filled head, good ear placement, gentle profile. Stands square, good bone, shoulders well placed and holds his level topline. Good turn of stifle, moves well, like his 2 brothers just needs time to develop chest and spring of rib, one of the better movers.

2. Holmes' **Hopscotch Hero**.

3 year old tricolour, good make and shape with plenty of bone. His head slightly lacks fill under the eye and I would like more profile, nice length to neck into well laid shoulders and straight front. Level topline and good tail carriage, moved well.

Post Graduate Dog (3 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Lister's **Emred Double Dealer Reserve Best Dog**

20 month old white dog with black ear, very tidy boy not exaggerated in any way. Good profile with gentle curve, keen expression, good ear placement but bit reluctant to use them, chest has depth, strong bone to

a straight front, short level back with good tail carriage and turn of stifle, hard to assess movement, needs a long time to settle.

2. Allison & Hewitt's **Precious Hero**.

2 year old white dog, nice length to head, good expression, ample bone with tight feet, straight front, slightly long cast and would prefer more turn to stifle, moved OK.

Limit Dog (0 Entries)

Open Dog (4 Entries, 2 Absent)

1. Leggatt's **Javarke Karbon Kopy At Rabram**.

Best Dog & Best Opposite Sex

3 year old masculine black brindle who has great bone and substance, his head is full of power with plenty of width and deep underjaw, well placed ears and great expression, solid round bone and good deep forechest, strong neck into well placed shoulders, short backed with correct tail set and well turned stifles, moves with power although better coming than going.

2. Pilkington's **Int Ch. Javarke Pitch Black**.

5 year old tricoloured dog, not quite the power or bone of 1, head has good ear and eye placement and nice turn, good reach of neck, short backed, stands square, moves well both ways.

Veteran Dog or Bitch (2 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. McDonagh & McLeish's **White Viper At Irazistabull**.

8 year old white dog with brindle ear, well made with good solid head, nice ear placement, straight front with good round bone and tight feet, moves well but slightly wide on front.

Minor Puppy Dog (2 Entries, 2 Absent)

Puppy Bitch (6 Entries, 4 Absent)

1. Leggatt's **Rabram Rolling Deep**.

Best Puppy

10 month old white bitch with brindle ears, mature for her age, feminine head with plenty of length and profile, good roman finish, nice length of neck, square front with good depth of chest for a puppy, tight feet, short back and holds level topline when she moves.

2. Allison & Hewitt's **Indigo Inca**.

10 month old brindle and white bitch, more substantial than 1 with solid round bone, good length of head with width and depth, strong straight front and good turn of stifle, loses topline slightly on the move but moves well.

Junior Bitch (5 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Din & Lowe's **Selbullie Is Miss Divine**.

15 month old white bitch with brindle ear, very feminine bitch with good length and enough turn to head. Straight front with good feet and enough bone for size, slightly long cast but has ample turn of stifle and moved OK.

2. Hedges' **Serenbull Back To Black At Civert**.

13 month old tricolour bitch, smaller

type than 1, short filled compact head with width and plenty of turn, keen expression and uses her ears well, enough bone and substance for size, good length of back and good tail set, moved well.

3. Pilkington's **Javarke Make A Wish**.

4. Rodger's **Gypsy Rose Joe's Star At Mysibul**.

Novice Bitch (3 Entries, 3 Absent)

Post Graduate Bitch (5 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Musgrove's **Megaville Star Gazing Into Japulca**.

2 year old white bitch, sweeping profile with keen expression and good ear carriage, long neck into good shoulders and straight front with enough bone, can look long cast but when she shows she holds together very well. Strong rear quarters which move her with drive when settled.

2. Littlefair's **Dikram Run With The Devil**.

2 year old white bitch with black ear and eye patch, good solid well filled head with plenty of turn and keen expression, ample bone and substance and good tight feet, short backed with good rear angulation which she uses to drive at speed although she can lose her topline slightly.

3. McDonagh & McLeish's **Irazistabull Pandora's Star**.

4. Hickman's **Quentinhill Hell's Spell For Bullambi**.

Limit Bitch (1 Entry, 1 Absent)

Open Bitch (3 Entries, 1 Absent)

1. Littlefair's **Dikram Tribal Magic**.

Best Bitch & Best In Show

4 year old tricolour bitch who shows herself very well, short well filled compact head which has depth and width all the way to the muzzle. Great expression with small well placed ears, good reach of neck into good shoulders and straight front, short backed with enough turn of stifle and correct tail carriage. In gleaming condition and moves well both ways with ease, her maturity showed through.

2. McDonagh & McLeish's **Irazistabull Star Of Athena**.

Reserve Best Bitch

3 year old white bitch with ear patch, beautiful length of head with sweeping profile, keen eye, ears could be slightly better, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, straight front with good bone and correct tight feet, good length of leg, rear angulation is good and she moves well, a close decision.
